LAST GAME: Brooklyn took a pair from the Lowell Spinners on Sunday afternoon, winning a suspended game by the score of 3-2 and then taking a 7-inning night cap 4-0...The Cyclones played as the Brooklyn Bagels in tribute to the city's deep seeded roots with the breakfast staple...Over 13.0 innings spanning the two games Cyclones pitchers did not allow a run.

WHO'S HOT?: C **Nick Meyer** is batting .364 (8-22) over his last six games...OF **Wagner Lagrange** is batting .414 (12-29) over his last eight games with an at-bat...SS **Manny Rodriguez** is hitting .316 (6-19) over his last six games.

HE'S HEATING UP: INF **Carlos Cortes** has reached base safely in nine straight games and is batting .417 (5-12) over his last three games...Cortes is batting .333 (5-15) when batting sixth or lower in the order and .189 (7-37) when batting fifth or higher.

SHUT IT DOWN: Cyclones pitchers rank second in the New York-Penn League with six shutouts this season...Hudson Valley leads the way with eight and no other team has more than three...The franchise record for shutouts is 11, set in 2003...Brooklyn and Hudson Valley are also the only two teams in the NYPL to not be shutout themselves.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: Brooklyn currently ranks second in the league with a .978 fielding percentage...Brooklyn has just 29 errors in 1327 total changes.

ROAD SWEET ROAD?: Brooklyn has scored 90 runs in 17 road games and 68 runs in 19 home games...1B **Chase Chambers** is batting .364 (20-55) in road games and .237 (14-59) at MCU Park...INF **Carlos Cortes** is hitting .333 (7-21) on the road and just .161 (5-31) at home.

vs. MAHONING VALLEY: The Cyclones are 28-25 against the Mahoning Valley Scrappers all-time including 15-14 at Eastwood Field in Niles, OH... Brooklyn was swept in a three-game series against the Scrappers in 2017 and have not won a game in Ohio since July 25, 2015...The Cyclones and Scrappers played the first game in MCU Park history on June 25, 2001 with the Cyclones winning 3-2 in 10.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn is 16-7 in games when they score the first run of the game.

STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 14-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

TRAVELING JAMES: Tonight will mark the seventh time in 18 road games that RHP **Christian James** will be the starting pitcher...The righthander has made his one home start, but is 2-0 with a 2.30 ERA in six road starts entering tonight's contest.

EARLY AND OFTEN: The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 51-30 over the first two innings of the game.

TO THE LEFT: INF **Chandler Avant** is batting .318 (7-22) against southpaws this season while the Cyclones as a team are batting just .236...OF **Jose Medina** is hitting just .120 (3-25) against lefties.

TRANSACTIONS: INF **Jose Brizuela** was transferred to Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League...INF **Walter Rasquin** was removed from his MiLB Rehab Assignment and added to the Cyclones roster.

GETTING MIGGY WITH IT: OF **Jose Medina** is batting .349 (15-43) when leading off an inning - including .385 (10-26) when leading off the first inning.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win of the season Wednesday at Tri-City, tossing six innings of three-run ball (two-earned)...Allowed a three-run home run to 'Cats slugger Alex McKenna in the first inning before bouncing back with five scoreless in Brooklyn's 11-5 win.

LEFT/RIGHT: With Brooklyn, has held left-handed batters to just a .196 average (10-51), but RHB are hitting .298 (25-84) off of him.

BEFORE BROOKLYN: Made two starts this season at higher levels before joining the Cyclones...Pitched with St. Lucie (A+) of the Florida State League on June 2nd vs. Fort Myers...Tossed 5.0 innings, allowed one run on one hit while striking out five....Took a no-decision in a game that Fort Myers won 3-1...Also made a spot start with Binghamton (AA) of the Eastern League on May 27th vs. Bowie...Was tagged with the loss, but allowed just one run on three hits over 4.0 innings with one walk and four strikeouts.

BASEBALL AMERICA: The publication named James New York's 30th-best prospect in their 2018 handbook.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-3 with a 4.18 ERA in 11 games, all starts, with the Kingsport Mets (R) of the Appy League...Allowed one earned run or less in six of 11 starts...Began the season with a 0.74 ERA through his first five starts, allowing just four runs, two earned, over 24.1 innings on the mound.

K TURN: Struck out 58 batters in 51.0 innings with the K-Mets last season...Including three games in which he struck out nine batters, which established and tied his career high.

SCHOOL DAYS: Was selected in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of East Lake HS...Went 9-2 with a 1.29 ERA and 98 strikeouts in 71.0 innings during his senior year...Committed to FIU before signing with the Mets.
