LAST GAME: Brooklyn cut an early deficit to 2-1, but fell by that mark Wednesday in the middle game of the three-game series to the Scrappers... LHP **Kevin Smith** suffered his first pro loss, allowing two early runs (one earned)...3B **Brian Sharp** provided the lone spark offensively, going 2-4 with an RBI...**Adam Hill, Tylor Megill, and Trent Johnson** combined for six shutout innings of relief.

ARM STRENGTH: With six more scoreless innings of relief last night, the Cyclones bullpen has posted a 1.26 ERA in 19 of the teams past 20 games... RHP **Yeudy Colon** has tossed a team-high 12.1 consecutive scoreless innings.

LEASH THE DOGS: Entering the series, Mahoning Valley led the league in batting (.263) and runs per game (5.4), but Cyclones pitching has held the Scrappers to just three runs over the first two games of the series, marking just the third time this season the Scrappers have been held to two runs or fewer in consecutive games.

BACK TO THE HEARTLAND: Brooklyn has four players with ties to Ohio on the current roster, including OF **Ross Adolph** (Findlay) and C **Hayden Senger** (Hamilton)...RHP **Kyle Wilson** was born in Canton and SS **Manny Rodriguez** played collegiately at Cincinnati.

WHO'S HOT?: OF **Wagner Lagrange** is batting .406 (13-32) over his last nine games with an at-bat, including two hits last night...OF **Ross Adolph** is batting .357 (10-28) over his last seven games.

HE'S HEATING UP: INF **Carlos Cortes** has reached base safely in 11 straight games and is batting .389 (7-18) over his past five contests...Cortes is batting .333 (7-21) when batting sixth or lower in the order and .189 (7-37) when batting fifth or higher.

vs. MAHONING VALLEY: The Cyclones are 28-27 against the Mahoning Valley Scrappers all-time including 15-16 at Eastwood Field in Niles, OH... Brooklyn was swept in a three-game series against the Scrappers in 2017 and have not won a game in Ohio since July 25, 2015...The Cyclones and Scrappers played the first game in MCU Park history on June 25, 2001 with the Cyclones winning 3-2 in 10.

ROAD SWEET ROAD?: Brooklyn has scored 91 runs in 19 road games (4.8 r/g) and 68 runs in 19 home games (3.6 r/g)...1B **Chase Chambers** is batting .350 (21-60) in road games and .237 (14-59) at MCU Park...INF **Carlos Cortes** is hitting .333 (9-27) on the road and just .161 (5-31) at home.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn is 16-7 in games when they score the first run of the game.

STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 14-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

EARLY AND OFTEN: The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 51-32 over the first two innings of the game.

EXTRA EXTRA!: 1B **Chase Chambers** does not have an extra base hit in his last 27 at-bats after having four extra base hits in three games prior to that stretch...The slugger who led the NCAA in RBI is 5-for-27 over his past eight games.

PAY YOUR AGE: On Monday, July 30th all kids will be able to Pay Your Age for tickets to the 7:00 PM game against the Tri-City ValleyCats...If a child is four years old, they pay \$4...One adult ticket is required for every four children's tickets sold.

SHUT IT DOWN: Tuesday night marked the first time this season that Brooklyn's bats have been shutout.
