LAST GAME: Kyle Wilson tossed seven shutout innings, SS Manny Rodriguez went 3-4 with a double, triple, and three RBIs, sending the Cyclones to a 7-1 win over West Virginia in the series opener... Brooklyn has combined for 19 runs on 27 hits over its past two games.

JULY JIVE: Cyclones pitching has posted a 2.53 ERA in the month of July, second-best in the NY-Penn League behind Staten Island's 2.01 team ERA...Brooklyn starters have a 2.58 ERA, while the bullpen has a 2.46 ERA over 25 games this month.

TURNING THINGS AROUND: Brooklyn has won 10 of its past 15 games after starting July 2-8...The Cyclones enter Saturday's game 4 1/2 games behind division-leading Hudson Valley, tied with Staten Island for second place.

ARM STRENGTH: The Cyclones bullpen has posted a 1.65 ERA in 21 of the team's past 22 games... RHP Yeudy Colon tossed a team-high 14 consecutive scoreless innings...Billy Oxford, Adam Hill, and Colon each have ERAs sub-1.00.

ROAD SWEET ROAD?: Brooklyn has scored 110 runs in 21 road games (5.2 r/g) and 68 runs in 19 home games (3.6 r/g)...1B Chase Chambers is batting .357 (25-70) in road games and .237 (14-59) at MCU Park...INF Carlos Cortes is hitting .333 (12-36) on the road and just .161 (5-31) at home.

HE'S HEATING UP: INF Carlos Cortes has reached base safely in 13 straight games and is batting .370 (10-27) over his past seven contests...Since July 18, the Mets' third-round draft selection out of South Carolina this season has raised his average from .175 to .254.

vs. WEST VIRGINIA: The Cyclones are 4-6 all-time against the Black Bears since their inception in 2015, moving from Jamestown (NY)...Brooklyn is just 2-5 at Monongalia County Ballpark, going 1-2 in West Virginia in 2017...The Black Bears have visited MCU Park once, coming to Coney Island in 2016...In that series, the Cyclones won two out of three games against the Pittsburgh affiliate.

LEASH THE DOGS: Entering Brooklyn's previous series, Mahoning Valley led the league in batting (.263) and runs per game (5.4), but Cyclones pitching held the Scrappers to just seven runs over the three-game series.

BACK TO HIS ROOTS PART ONE: Findlay, Ohio native Ross Adolph went 4-5 with a triple, a home run, three RBIs, and three runs in his return to Ohio Thursday, doing all of his damage in Brooklyn's 12-4 win over Mahoning Valley.

BACK TO HIS ROOTS PART TWO: C Hayden Senger, who played Friday night, is reunited with his college roommate, West Virginia pitcher Zachary Spears...Both played their college ball at Miami (OH) University in Oxford, Ohio...Senger was drafted in the 24th round by the Mets while Spears was selected in the eighth round by Pittsburgh.

GOING, GOING, BACK, BACK: Brooklyn homered twice in one game for the second time this season and second time this month...Thursday night in Niles, Chase Chambers and Ross Adolph combined for a pair of home runs, while Jose Medina launched two at Tri-City on July 18.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn is 18-7 in games when they score the first run of the game.

STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 16-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed just three innings in a suspended game against Lowell last Friday at MCU Park...Surrendered two runs on four hits in Brooklyn's eventual 3-2 win over the Spinners.

ON TOP IN JUNE: Posted a 2.19 ERA in June, winning two of three starts...Struck out 11 in 12.1 innings, yielding just eight hits for an opponents batting average of .182...collected wins against Staten Island and Connecticut.

JUST NOT HIS JULY: Has lost three of his four starts, recording a 7.63 ERA...Has allowed 13 earned runs on 22 hits in 15.1 innings for an opponents batting average of .338.

PULL NO PUNCHES: Batters have pulled 57% of the pitches put in play, hitting 23.3% to the opposite field, and 19.8% center...Opposing batters have hit 29.4% of balls in play as line drives, the highest of Campusano's career.

DON'T WALK AWAY FROM ME: For his career, the Dominican has a 6.9% walk rate, having allowed just 49 walks of 713 total batters faced in 171.1 career innings.

DOWN FROM ABOVE: Had made four starts this season prior to the start of the Cyclones season, pitching three times for Class-A Columbia and once with Advanced-A St. Lucie...Suffered the tough-luck loss for the Fireflies on June 11 at Lexington, allowing two runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings...Compiled a 1-1 record and a 3.55 ERA with Columbia...Pitched for Advanced-A St. Lucie on April 22, taking the loss...Allowed one run on two hits over four innings, strikout out four and walking three.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-6 with a 2.89 ERA over 13 games and nine starts covering four levels...Pltched for the GCL Mets, Kingsport, Brooklyn, and St. Lucie...Tossed a season-high 33.0 innings for the GCL Mets, going 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA over seven games and four starts.
