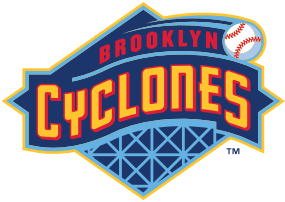

LAST GAME: Brooklyn claimed another series win, scoring the first seven runs of the ballgame en route to a 7-1 victory at West Virginia on Sunday evening...RHP **Jaison Vilera** (5-1) earned the win with another spectacular start, working seven scoreless innings of two-hit ball while striking out eight...Four Cyclones had multi-hit games...DH **Walter Rasquin** and SS **Manny Rodriguez** each went 2-for-3 with a run.

JULY JIVE: Cyclones pitching has posted a 2.54 ERA in the month of July, second-best in the NY-Penn League behind Staten Island's 1.85 team ERA...Brooklyn starters have a 2.47 ERA, while the bullpen has a 2.63 ERA over 27 games this month.

TURNING THINGS AROUND: Brooklyn has won 11 of its past 17 games and five of its last six series after starting July 2-8...The Cyclones enter Monday's game 4 1/2 games behind division-leading Hudson Valley, good for third place.

ROAD SWEET ROAD?: Brooklyn has scored 119 runs in 23 road games (5.2 r/g) and 68 runs in 19 home games (3.6 r/g)...1B **Chase Chambers** is batting .329 (26-79) in road games and .237 (14-59) at MCU Park...OF **Wagner Lagrange** is hitting .333 (25-75) on the road and just .224 (13-58) at home.

DON'T LEAVE ME: Brooklyn stranded 7 runners on base Sunday night...The Cyclones have left 312 men on base, the third-most in the league behind State College (318) and Vermont (317).

ARM STRENGTH: In the last nine games, the Brooklyn bullpen has allowed just 7 earned runs over 29 innings (2.17 ERA)...RHP **Yeudy Colon** has allowed just one earned run in 17.1 relief frames... Along with Colon, relievers **Billy Oxford**, **Adam Hill**, **Tommy Wilson**, and **Ryley Gilliam** each have sub-2.00 ERAs.

vs. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 48-42 all-time against the ValleyCats, including 24-18 at MCU Park...Brooklyn has already faced Tri-City in 2018, winning two of three games in mid-July in Troy, NY...The Cyclones have hosted the ValleyCats for a three-game set each of the last 13 seasons, winning that series nine times...Brooklyn hasn't won a season series with Tri-City since 2010, when the Cyclones went 4-2.

WHO'S THE NEW GUY?: RHP **Jose Butto** will make the start in his Cyclones debut tonight...The 20-year-old was promoted from Kingsport (R) yesterday, where he led the team in wins (3), ERA (1.93), and innings pitched (32.2)...This will be Butto's first appearance above the Rookie level.

TAKE TWO WITH TRI-CITY: Two weeks ago, Brooklyn took two of three games in a series at Tri-City...The Cyclones scored 19 runs on 33 hits over the three-game set...OF **Wagner Lagrange** went 7-for-12 with two runs and two RBIs in the series.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn is 19-7 in games when they score the first run of the game.

STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 16-1 when leading after seven innings this season.

EARLY AND OFTEN: The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 52-33 (+19) over the first two innings of the game.

EASY AS 1, 2, 3, 4: Brooklyn is 19-3 in games when it scores four or more runs.

PAY YOUR AGE: All kids will be able to Pay Your Age for tickets to tonight's game against the Tri-City ValleyCats...If a child is four years old, they pay \$4...One adult ticket is required for every four children's tickets sold.

LAST TIME OUT: Spun the first complete-game victory of his career, working six innings of one-run ball in a rain-shortened win over Danville on Tuesday... Collected his third quality start of the year...Allowed just three hits, including a solo home run, and walked one while striking out six.....Threw a season-high 87 pitches, 56 for strikes.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: Was promoted from the Kingsport Mets (R) yesterday...Making his debut at the Short-Season Class A level...Joins Josh Walker, Anthony Dirocie, and Hayden Senger as current Cyclones who were on Kingsport's 2018 Opening Day roster.

LEADING THE WAY: Led the K-Mets in wins (3), ERA (1.93), innings pitched (32.2), and WHIP (1.16)...Tied for the team lead in starts (6) and ranked second in strikeouts (32)...Among qualifiers, led the Appalachian League in both ERA and WHIP.

LEFT ON BASE: Led all Appalachian League qualifiers in Left on Base Percentage, having stranded 92.4 percent of the runners who have reached base on him this season.

I'M THE WINNER: Collected a victory in each of his last three outings with Kingsport, two of which were quality starts.

NO RUNS HERE: Owns a career 1.63 ERA, having allowed just 15 earned runs over 82.2 career innings...Has never allowed more than three runs in a single outing.

NEW TO THE U.S.A.: The Venezuelan-born pitcher is making his stateside debut in 2018 after spending all of 2017 in the Dominican Summer League...With the DSL Mets2, went 1-1 with a save and a 1.44 ERA last year...Tossed 50 innings over 15 appearances (8 starts), allowing just 8 earned runs and striking out 41 batters.

- Removing the bullpen's five earned runs allowed July 18 at Tri-City, the relievers have combined for 16 ER in 75.1IP (1.91 ERA) over 23 of the past 24 games.
 - RHP Yeudy Colon has a team-low 0.52 ERA, having allowed one earned run over 17.1IP. Colon snapped his team-long 14-inning scoreless streak Friday, the longest for a Cyclones reliever this season.
 - RHP Tylor Megill fanned a career-high four batters over a career-high three innings, having not allowed a run Wednesday at Mahoning Valley.
 - RHP Ryley Gilliam has not allowed an earned run in six innings and six appearances as a professional.
