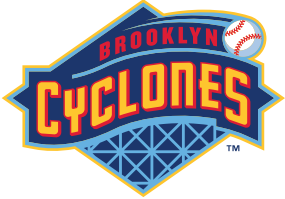

**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones fell to the IronBirds on Thursday night by the score of 2-1...Brooklyn squandered several scoring chances, including a bases loaded threat with nobody out in the fifth and seventh innings...Brooklyn went just 2-for-11 with RISP and left 10 men on...RHP **Jaison Vilera** was the hard-luck loser after allowing just two runs over a season-high 7.0 IP while striking out eight, which tied a career high.

**ROAD SWEET ROAD:** Brooklyn is hitting .286 (95-332) in nine road games this season and .234 (86-367) in 11 home games...Brooklyn has scored 58 runs on the road and 41 runs at home...Brooklyn has scored a total of four runs in their last four home games.

**WHO'S HOT?:** After starting his pro career batting .063 (1-16), OF **David Miranda** is batting .389 (7-18) over his last seven games...C **Nick Meyer** went 0-for-4 in his pro debut but has hit safely in each of his starts since then...Meyer is batting .375 (9-24) over his last six games.

**WHO'S NOT?:** OF **Jose Medina** is 2-for-20 over his last five games...INF **Jose Brizuela** is 3-for-20 over his last five games.

**GET AHEAD:** The Cyclones have scored the first run of the game in 14 of 20 games this season...Brooklyn is 9-5 in those games.

**THE K IN BROOKLYN:** The Cyclones rank fourth in the New York-Penn League with 180 strikeouts on the season...Connecticut leads the league with 222 punchouts, Staten Island ranks second at 202, and Lowell is third at 182...OF **Ross Adolph** leads the team with 24 strikeouts, including at least one in 13 of his 17 games with an at-bat...1B **Chase Chambers** has five strikeouts in his last 13 at-bats after striking out just six times in his first 39 at-bats.

**vs. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones are 94-70 all-time against the IronBirds including 45-39 at home...The Cyclones went 2-10 against Aberdeen in 2017 with their lone home win coming on July 24th courtesy of a 4-3 win in 11 innings...The Cyclones were outscored 75-35 last year and Brooklyn had a team ERA of 5.83.

**THE LONELIEST NUMBER:** Brooklyn has been limited to one run on six different occasions this season, including five times at MCU Park...Dating back to June 24th, Brooklyn has scored a total of 11 runs in seven home games and has gone 2-5 in these contests.

**TWO-OUT TROUBLE:** Brooklyn has allowed 93 runs this season, with 42 of them coming with two outs (45.2%).

**TROUBLE AT HOME?:** OF **Ross Adolph** has struck out 17 times in 33 at-bats at MCU Park...1B **Chase Chambers** is batting just .133 (4-30) at MCU Park but .500 (16-32) on the road.

**LEAVE 'EM HANGING:** Brooklyn has left 154 runners on base this season, third-most in the NYPL behind State College (161) and Vermont (157)...As a team, Brooklyn is batting .286 (93-325) with runners on base...1B **Chase Chambers** is hitting a whopping .433 (13-30) with runners on base and .444 (8-18) with runners in scoring position.

**HIT THE SKIDS:** After starting the season 8-2, Brooklyn has gone 3-7 and has been outscored 63-40 in these games.

**SUNDAY IS THURSDAY:** New York Mets pitcher **Noah Syndergaard** will be the starting pitcher for the Cyclones on Sunday...Every fan in attendance will receive a Syndergaard as Thor T-shirt courtesy of Marvel.

**LAST SEASON:** Spent his first professional season with the GCL Mets, going 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in seven appearances...Made two starts and five relief appearances, striking out 19 batters in 18.0 innings.

**CROWDER COLLEGE:** Wilson played his collegiate ball at Crowder College in Missouri, leading his team to a NJCAA World Series in 2017...Posted a 3-1 record and 2.27 ERA that season for the Roughriders.

**HIGH SCHOOL DRAFTEE:** The Minnesota Twins selected Wilson in the 19th round of the 2015 draft out of Raymore-Peculiar High School in Peculiar, Missouri before maintaining his college commitment.

**MORE ON RAYMORE:** Wilson grew up in Raymore, Missouri, a town of more than 20,000 people...According to the city's 2015 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, the Raymore-Peculiar School District employees the most people in town (344). Rounding out the top 10 employers in Raymore are Golden Corral (#9, 80 employees) and Minsky's Pizza (#10, 26).

**LIKE LEO:** Wilson's favorite movie is Shutter Island starring Leonardo DiCaprio, the actor Wilson believes would play him in a movie about his life.

- Monday night, Billy Oxford, Ryan Selmer, and Yeudy Colon combined for 5.1 scoreless innings, the bullpen's first scoreless outing in seven games. The last time Cyclones relievers didn't allow a run was in a 1-0 shutout win over Lowell on Sunday, June 24.
- LHP Kevin Smith has fired six scoreless innings over his first three professional appearances, including Tuesday's start.
- RHP Mac Lozer snapped his 7.1 IP scoreless streak to start the season Sunday vs. Staten Island, allowing a two-run home run to Andres Chaparro.
- RHP Yeudy Colon has a team-low 0.93 ERA, having allowed one run over 9.2 IP. Colon is in the midst of a 6.2 scoreless-innings streak.
