LAST GAME: The Cyclones used a pair of RBI from OF **Jose Medina** and dominant pitching from RHP **Noah Syndergaard** LHP **Kevin Smith** and RHP **Ryley Gilliam** to take Sunday's game by the score of 2-1 at MCU Park...Medina went 2-for-4 and his eighth inning RBI broke a 1-1 tie...RHP **Noah Syndergaard** made the start for Brooklyn and allowed one run on two hits with one walk and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings on the mound.

CUTTING IT CLOSE: Brooklyn and Staten Island have split the season series to this point 4-4...Five of the eight games have been decided by two runs or less.

POWER SURGE: The Cyclones have allowed 11 HR this season (tied for fifth-most in the NYPL), with six coming in the past eight games...The past four home runs, and five of the previous six, have allowed the opponent to tie or take the lead.

WHO'S HOT?: After starting his pro career batting .063 (1-16), OF **David Miranda** is batting .429 (6-14) over his last six games...C **Nick Meyer** went 0-for-4 in his pro debut but has since compiled an eight-game hitting streak...Meyer is batting .387 (12-31) with four multi-hit games over that stretch.

WHO'S NOT?: INF **Jose Brizuela** is 5-for-32 (.156) over his last eight games...OF **Wagner Lagrange** is 7-for-39 (.179) over his last 10 games.

GET AHEAD: The Cyclones have scored the first run of the game in 14 of 23 games this season...Brooklyn is 9-5 in those games.

BORN ON THE 1st OF JULY: Since the calendar turned to July, Brooklyn has gone just 2-6 and scored just 19 runs in these eight games...The Cyclones are hitting just .210 (53-252) with ten extra base hits.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 114-111 all-time against the Yankees, including 4-4 so far this season...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other team in the NYPL...The Cyclones are 53-58 all time at Richmond County Bank Ballpark including 2-2 this season...Brooklyn has not won the season series over the Baby Bombers since 2014 when they went 8-6.

THURS-DAY: Yesterday's sellout crowd of 7,404 was the second largest crowd of the year for Brooklyn behind Opening Day...More than 3,200 tickets were sold from July 4th at 4 PM when it was announced that Syndergaard would be pitching.

REHAB ASSIGNMENT: For the second consecutive day, Brooklyn will have a Major League Rehab starter on the mound...It will mark the 26th time that a major leaguer has joined the Cyclones and the 12th time it has been a pitcher.

TWO-OUT TROUBLE: Brooklyn has allowed 102 runs this season, with 45 of them coming with two outs (43.5%).

A CASE OF THE RUNS: In eight July games, Cyclones pitchers have issued 22 walks and hit seven batters...15 of those 29 runners (51.7%) have come around to score.

LEAVE 'EM HANGING: Brooklyn has left 169 runners on base this season, fourth-most in the NYPL behind State College (184), Vermont (180) and West Virginia (172).

HIT THE SKIDS: After starting the season 8-2, Brooklyn has gone 4-9 and has been outscored 72-47 in these games...The Cyclones won their first four series of the season but have since lost their last three.

How Obtained: Signed as a free agent on February 18, 2018 to a two-year contract with a team option for a third year.

REHAB ROAD: New York Mets placed LHP Jason Vargas on the 10-day disabled list retroactive to June 20 with a strained right calf.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his sixth loss of the season on June 19 versus Colorado at Coors Field...Pitched 2.1 innings and gave up seven runs, earned, on nine hits including a season-high tying three homers...Did not walk or strike out a single batter...The 2.1 innings accounted for the shortest outing since giving up seven runs over 2.0 innings at Detroit on September 5, 2017 as a member of the Kansas City Royals...Last gave up three home runs in a game in his 2018 season debut at San Diego on April 28.

ALL-STAR-WORTHY 2017: At the All-Star Break last season, Vargas led the American League in both wins (12) and ERA (2.62), while ranking among the league leaders in WHIP (1.15, 11th) and walks per nine innings (2.12, eighth)...Won seven consecutive starts from May 27-June 30, 2017...Pitched a complete game shutout on June 2 vs. Cleveland, his 12th career complete game and seventh shutout...Was the first pitcher in the majors to reach 10 wins, doing so in his 14th start on June 18...Posted a sub-2.00 ERA in both April and June...Was 6-0 with a 1.98 ERA (nine earned runs/41.0 innings) in his six June starts with 23 strikeouts and nine walks.

A CAREER ON THE MOVE: Vargas was selected by the Florida Marlins in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft...Acquired by the Mets on November 20, 2006 and started two games in 2007...Acquired by Seattle in December 2008 as part of a three-team, 12-player trade...Traded from Seattle to Los Angeles-AL on December 19, 2012 in exchange for Kendrys Morales...Signed a four-year contract by the Kansas City Royals in November 2013.

MEDICAL HISTORY: Underwent surgery on March 20 to remove hamate bone in his right hand...Underwent Tommy John Surgery in 2015, missing July 22-September 17, 2016...Experienced left flexor strain over two 15-day DL stints in 2015...Blood clot in left arm on 15-day DL from June 18-August 13, 2013...Missed 2008 undergoing

- Monday night, Billy Oxford, Ryan Selmer, and Yeudy Colon combined for 5.1 scoreless innings, the bullpen's first scoreless outing in seven games. The last time Cyclones relievers didn't allow a run was in a 1-0 shutout win over Lowell on Sunday, June 24.
- LHP Kevin Smith has fired nine scoreless innings over his first four professional appearances, including Sunday's three-inning relief appearance.
- RHP Mac Lozer snapped his 7.1 IP scoreless streak to start the season 7/2 vs. Staten Island, allowing a two-run home run to Andres Chaparro.
- RHP Yeudy Colon has a team-low 0.93 ERA, having allowed one run over 9.2 IP. Colon is in the midst of a 6.2 scoreless-innings streak.
