OPENING DAY: The Cyclones are 12-5 all-time on Opening Day including 10-4 against the Staten Island Yankees...Brooklyn has lost on Opening Day each of the last two years, both against Staten Island...In 2016, current Cyclone INF **Dionis Paulino** was tagged with the loss in a 20-inning marathon that saw Brooklyn fall 3-2 after several position players were called into pitch for the Cyclones.

WHO'S IN CHARGE HERE?: Cyclones manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** will not be with the team this weekend as he is inducted into the Latin American Baseball Hall of Fame...He is expected to rejoin the Cyclones in time for Monday's game against Hudson Valley...Bench Coach **Rich Donnelly**, who served as the Cyclones manager from 2011-2013, will serve as manager in his place...Donnelly ranks second all-time with 128 career wins as manager.

FROM BROOKLYN TO QUEENS: There have been four players who have been in the Opening Day lineup for the Brooklyn Cyclones and the New York Mets, including two this year...**Mike Jacobs** was the Opening Day catcher for the Cyclones in the first game in franchise history in 2001, and then the Mets Opening Day first baseman in 2010...**Lucas Duda** was the DH for the Cyclones in 2007 and was in the Mets Opening Day lineup four times...This season SS **Amed Rosario** (2014) and OF **Brandon Nimmo** (2012) were both in the starting nine for the Amazins for the first time.

SOMETHING OLD: Ten players on the Opening Day roster have played for the Cyclones previously including 2017 Sterling Award Winner RHP **Nicolas Debora** and 2017 NYPL All-Star OF **Jose Medina**...In addition, RHP **Brian Campusano**, LHP **Joel Huertas**, RHP **Trent Johnson**, RHP **Ryan McAuliffe**, INF **Dionis Paulino**, INF **Carl Stajduhar**, OF **Wagner Lagrange**, C **Carlos Sanchez**, and rehabbing 3B **David Thompson** have played for Brooklyn.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 110-107 all-time against the Staten Island Yankees...Brooklyn has played Staten Island more than any other New York-Penn League team...They are 51-56 all-time at Richmond County Bank Ballpark...Brooklyn went 6-7 against Staten Island in 2017 and has not won a season series against the Baby Bombers since 2014.

SOMETHING NEW: There are currently eight players from the recent MLB Draft on the Cyclones roster including OF **Ross Adolph** (12th Round - Toledo) and INF **Manny Rodriguez** (10th Round - Cincinnati) who are in the starting lineup for tonight's game and will be making their professional debut this evening.

SOMETHING BORROWED: 3B **David Thompson** will begin a MiLB Rehab assignment with the Brooklyn Cyclones this evening...Thompson suffered a hairline fracture in his hand when he was hit by a pitch on April 29th with Las Vegas (AAA) at Albuquerque...Thompson was hitting .258 (17-66) in 22 games with the 51s prior to his injury...The former Miami Hurricane made his pro debut with the Cyclones back in 2015.

CROSS THAT BRIDGE: OF **Kendall Coleman** will become the first player to suit up for both the Staten Island Yankees and the Brooklyn Cyclones when he makes his Cyclones debut...The outfielder has played in 118 games with Staten Island over two seasons...Coleman was traded from the Yankees organization to the Mets in exchange for former Cyclone **LJ Mazzilli** earlier this year.

THE NEED FOR SPEED: OF **Jose Medina** ranked third in the NYPL last year with 25 stolen bases...With eight more steals this season he would tie OF **Angel Pagan** for the franchise career record with 33 steals...INF **Walter Rasquin** led the NYPL and set a single-season Cyclones record with 32 stolen bases last year.
