YESTERDAY: The Cyclones won a thrilling contest on Tuesday night, defeating Hudson Valley by the score of 7-5...INF **Oliver Pascual** went 2-for-4 with a run scored and two RBI, including the go-ahead run, to pace the Brooklyn bats while RHP **Mac Lozer** collected his second save in as many chances after tossing a scoreless ninth inning.

THREE ABOVE: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with a record of 4-1...it makes the first time the team has been three games over .500 since August 19, 2016 when they were 31-28 following a loss at the hands of the Staten Island Yankees...Brooklyn was 2-1 after three games in 2017 but were never above .500 again for the remainder of the year.

FIRST PLACE: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with a two-game lead in the McNamara Division over the Hudson Valley Renegades...It's the first time that Brooklyn has been in sole possession of first place since July 23, 2015 when they were 18-13.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: The Cyclones have a chance to sweep a three-game series for the first time since they took three in a row from the Vermont Lake Monsters from August 8 - 11, 2016 here at MCU Park...The Cyclones have not swept a three-game series from Hudson Valley since June 17-19, 2014.

HOME COOKIN': Brooklyn is currently 3-0 at home to start the 2018 campaign, their best mark since 2010 when they began the year 6-0 at home.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: RHP **Ryley Gilliam** (5th round - Clemson), C **Nick Meyer** (6th round - Cal Poly) and RHP **Tommy Wilson** (19th round - Cal State Fullerton) have all joined the Cyclones...None of them are currently active, as they are all in the post-draft player progression, but should be activated in the next week to 10 days.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 94-79 against Hudson Valley all-time despite going 0-9 against the Renegades in 2017...The Cyclones were outscored 51-16 during the nine game sweep last season...Brooklyn is currently 2-0 against the Renegades in 2018...The Cyclones have not swept a three-game series from Hudson Valley since June 17-19, 2014 in what was a home/home series.

SEVEN HEAVEN: The Cyclones have scored seven runs or more in each of their three home games to start the 2018 season...During the entire 2017 season Brooklyn scored seven runs or more at home just three times in 38 contests.

FOUR-EVER: Brooklyn is currently 4-1...Last year, the Cyclones did not win their fourth game of the year until July 5 when they improved to 4-11 following a win at Tri-City.

HIT MEN: There are four players in the New York-Penn League that have hit safely in all five games to begin the 2018 NYPL Season including OF **Wagner La-grange** and OF **Jose Medina**...OF **Ricardo Cespedes**, who played for Brooklyn in 2017 before being traded to the Marlins in exchange for A.J. Ramos, has also hit safely in all five games to begin the year...Dating back to the final game of the 2017 season, OF Wagner La-grange currently has a six-game hitting streak.

LEADING OFF: Brooklyn is batting .359 (14-39) to lead off an inning so far this season with three extra-base hits and a pair of walks...Leadoff batters currently have a .405 on-base percentage and a .641 slugging percentage.

DOUBLE UP: The Cyclones currently rank second in the league with a .984 fielding percentage, with just three errors in 187 total chances...Brooklyn leads the league with eight double plays turned in five games.

LAST SEASON: Spent his first professional season with the GCL Mets, going 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in seven appearances... Made two starts and five relief appearances, striking out 19 batters in 18.0 innings.

CROWDER COLLEGE: Wilson played his collegiate ball at Crowder College in Missouri, leading his team to a NJCAA World Series in 2017...Posted a 3-1 record and 2.27 ERA that season for the Roughriders.

HIGH SCHOOL DRAFTEE: The Minnesota Twins selected Wilson in the 19th round of the 2015 draft out of Raymore-Peculiar High School in Peculiar, Missouri.

MORE ON RAYMORE: Wilson grew up in Raymore, Missouri, a town of more than 20,000 people...According to the city's 2015 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, the Raymore-Peculiar School District employees the most people in town (344). Rounding out the top 10 employers in Raymore are Golden Corral (#9, 80 employees) and Minsky's Pizza (#10, 26).

LIKE LEO: Wilson's favorite movie is Shutter Island starring Leonardo DiCaprio, the actor Wilson believes would play him in a movie about his life.

- Ronald Sanchez and Mac Lozer have each secured at least one save for the Cyclones. In 2017, Brooklyn tallied 15 saves with two players, Gregorix Estevez and Conner O'Neil leading the team with three each.
- The bullpen snapped an 11-inning scoreless streak Monday night, dating back to the ninth inning Friday. Hudson Valley broke the streak with a three-run eighth inning against RHP Trent Johnson.
