**YESTERDAY:** The Cyclones made it two in a row on Friday night as they defeated the Tigers by the score of 9-1 at Dodd Stadium...RHP **Briam Campu-sano** (2-0) tossed 5.0 shutout frames, striking out eight...1B **Chase Chambers** went 3-for-5 with a pair of runs scored and an RBI and OF **Ross Adolph** went 3-for-4 with two runs scored and a pair of triples with four RBI.

**FIFTY SHADES:** The 50 runs that the Cyclones have scored through their first eight games is tied with the 2010 Cyclones for the best offensive start in franchise history.

**A RUN ON RUNS:** Brooklyn currently ranks third in the league with 50 runs scored...In 2017 the Cyclones scored their 50th run on July 4th, their 14th game of the year.

**FIRST PLACE:** The Cyclones come into tonight's game with a one-game lead in the McNamara Division over the Hudson Valley Renegades...It's the first time that Brooklyn has been in sole possession of first place since July 23, 2015 when they were 18-13.

**NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK:** RHP **Ryley Gilliam** (5th round - Clemson), C **Nick Meyer** (6th round - Cal Poly) and RHP **Tommy Wilson** (19th round - Cal State Fullerton) have all joined the Cyclones...None of them are currently active, as they are all in the post-draft player progression, but should be activated in the next week to 10 days.

**SERIES WINS:** With a Cyclones win last night, Brooklyn guaranteed wins in their first three series of the season for the first time since 2015 when they won the first six series of the year and were 14-6 to start the season...That team would go on to finish the year 33-43.

**vs. CONNECTICUT:** The Cyclones are 25-25 all-time against the Connecticut Tigers and have not won the season series against the Tigers since 2010 - Connecticut's first year in the NYPL...Brooklyn went 2-1 at Dodd Stadium in 2017, only the third time Brooklyn has won a series in Connecticut...Brooklyn is 13-14 all-time at Thomas J. Dodd Stadium in Norwich.

**SIX DEGREES OF SEPARATION:** Brooklyn is currently 6-2...Last year, the Cyclones did not win their five game of the year until July 9 when they improved to 6-14 following a win at Staten Island.

**HIT MEN:** Brooklyn OF **Wagner Lagrange** and OF **Jose Medina** have each hit safely in seven straight games to start the 2018 season...Lagrange is batting .286 (8-28) to start the year and Medina is batting .367 (11-30)...Lagrange actually has an eight-game hitting streak, officially, after hitting safely in th 2017 season finale with the Cyclones.

**LEADING OFF:** Brooklyn is batting .318 (21-66) to lead off an inning so far this season with four extra-base hits and a pair of walks...Leadoff batters currently have a .357 on-base percentage and a .545 slugging.

**DOUBLE UP:** The Cyclones currently lead the league with a .983 fielding percentage, with just five errors in 264 total chances...Brooklyn ranks second in the league with nine double plays.

**COMING UP:** When Brooklyn returns home on Sunday the team will wear special Paw Patrol Jerseys presented by Nickelodeon...The jerseys feature three of the characters from the hit children's show...Jerseys will be raffled off in park and auctioned off on-line at CyclonesAuthentics.com with proceeds to benefit Vs. Cancer - a pediatric cancer fund.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Tied a career-high striking out eight Staten Island Yankees over 4 2/3 innings of two-run ball Sunday...Did not get a decision in Brooklyn's 4-2 win on Father's Day.

**STERLING SILVER:** Debora earned Brooklyn's Sterling Award in 2017, a Mets recognition given to one player at each level of the minor leagues...Pitched 14 times for the Cyclones, with an even distribution between starts and relief appearances.

**MAMA SAID STRIKE YOU OUT:** The Dominican right-hander fanned 56 batters over 54.0 innings last season for Brooklyn...In his first start of this season for the Cyclones, Debora struck out eight batters, tying his career high for the third time in his seven season in the Mets organization...For his career, he has a 23% strikeout rate and 8.5 K/9.

**UP AND DOWN:** Made 12 appearances in relief (11 with Class-A Columbia and one with Advanced-A St. Lucie), posting a 2.91 ERA...Debora had never pitched above Short Season, Class A prior to this season.
