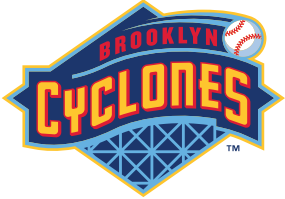

YESTERDAY: Brooklyn made it four in a row with a 1-0 win over the Lowell Spinners on Sunday afternoon at MCU Park...RHP **Jaison Vilera** tossed 6.0 shutout frames, scattering just two hits and striking out seven, to collect the win...OF **Wagner Lagrange** provided the offense with an RBI double in the third as the teams combined for just six hits.

HOT START: With yesterday's win, the Cyclones improved to 8-2 on the season, tied for the best start in franchise history...It marks the fourth time that Brooklyn has started 8-2, joining 2005, 2009 and 2014.

SHUT IT DOWN: The Cyclones collected their league-leading third shutout of the season last night... Brooklyn had three shutouts during the entire 2017 campaign...The franchise record for shutout is 11, set in 2003.

FIFTY SHADES: The 59 runs that the Cyclones have scored through their first 10 games is the best offensive start in franchise history...Brooklyn ranks second in the league with 59 runs scored (Tri-City - 60).

FIRST PLACE: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with a one-game lead in the McNamara Division over the Hudson Valley Renegades...It's the first time that Brooklyn has been in sole possession of first place since July 23, 2015 when they were 18-13.

SERIES WINS: The Cyclones have won their first three series of the season for the first time since 2015, when they won the first six series of the year and were 14-6 to start the season...That team would go on to finish the year 33-43.

SIX DEGREES OF SEPARATION: Brooklyn is currently 8-2...Last year, the Cyclones did not win their eighth game of the year until July 18th when they improved to 8-20 following a win vs. Staten Island.

vs. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 52-41 all-time against the Lowell Spinners, including 29-19 at MCU Park...Lowell has had a run of success recently, however, with Brooklyn going just 5-11 against the Spinners since 2016...The Cyclones went 4-2 against Lowell at MCU Park last season, but have not won a game in Lowell since 2015.

HIT MEN: Brooklyn OF **Wagner Lagrange** and OF **Jose Medina** have each hit safely in nine straight games to start the 2018 season...Lagrange is batting .343 (12-35) to start the year and Medina is batting .368 (14-38)...Statistically, Lagrange actually has a 10-game hitting streak after hitting safely in the Cyclones 2017 finale...It marks just the 39th time in franchise history that a player has collected a 10-or-more game hitting streak.

GET AHEAD: The Cyclones have scored the first run of the game in eight of 10 games this season...Brooklyn is 7-1 in those games.

DOUBLE UP: The Cyclones currently lead the league with a .984 fielding percentage, with just six errors in 380 total chances...Brooklyn is tied for the league lead with 10 double plays turned.

NEW KID IN TOWN: RHP **Adam Hill**, the 4th round selection of the Mets in the recent 2018 MLB Draft, has joined the team...The righthander went 7-5 with a 4.12 ERA (38 ER / 83 IP) in 16 games, all starts, with the Gamecocks in 2018...Struck out a career-high 14 batters twice during the 2018 campaign, including against Clemson on March 2nd...Finished the year with 101 Ks in 83.0 IP.

WE HARDLY KNEW YA: C **Matthew Foley** was transferred to Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League following yesterday's game.

CYCLONES DEBUT: Threw 3.2 innings on Wednesday in a 8-7, 10-inning loss to Hudson Valley...Struck out six while allowing four runs on six hits in the no-decision...It was his first career appearance at the Single-A level.

LAST SEASON: Spent his first professional season with the GCL Mets, going 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA in seven appearances...Made two starts and five relief appearances, striking out 19 batters in 18.0 innings.

CROWDER COLLEGE: Wilson played his collegiate ball at Crowder College in Missouri, leading his team to a NJCAA World Series in 2017...Posted a 3-1 record and 2.27 ERA that season for the Roughriders.

HIGH SCHOOL DRAFTEE: The Minnesota Twins selected Wilson in the 19th round of the 2015 draft out of Raymore-Peculiar High School in Peculiar, Missouri.

MORE ON RAYMORE: Wilson grew up in Raymore, Missouri, a town of more than 20,000 people...According to the city's 2015 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, the Raymore-Peculiar School District employees the most people in town (344). Rounding out the top 10 employers in Raymore are Golden Corral (#9, 80 employees) and Minsky's Pizza (#10, 26).

LIKE LEO: Wilson's favorite movie is Shutter Island starring Leonardo DiCaprio, the actor Wilson believes would play him in a movie about his life.

- LHP Seth Davis and RHP Ryan Selmer have each posted four scoreless innings, tying them for the longest active scoreless streak for a reliever on the team.
- RHP Mac Lozer has pitched four times over the first ten games, collecting two saves along the way. The Michigan Wolverine ranks second all-time with 100 appearances in his career in Ann Arbor, and is tied for the Cyclones lead in appearances.
- RHP Ezequiel Zabaleta fired three innings on Friday night, the most innings by a reliever in a game this season.
