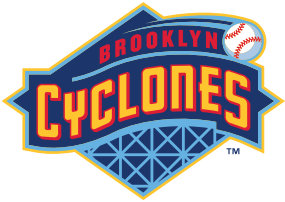

TUESDAY: The Cyclones took the rubber game of a three-game set from Lowell in dramatic fashion on Tuesday night, winning by the score of 4-3...OF **Jose Medina** tied things up in the ninth with an RBI double and later in the frame OF **Kendall Coleman** had a two-out, bases loaded, single that scored 1B **Dionis Paulino** to give Brooklyn the 4-3 win.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn is currently 2-2 in games when they are trailing after eight innings... Brooklyn was 0-41 in these situations in 2017...The 2008 Cyclones had three wins when trailing after eight innings, a franchise record.

SERIES WINS: The Cyclones have won their first four series of the season for the first time since 2015, when they won the first six series of the year and were 14-6 to start the season...That team would go on to finish the year 33-43.

ALL IS RIGHT: The Cyclones are hitting .274 (87-318) with a .412 slugging percentage against righthanded pitching, and .214 (21-98) with a .306 slugging against lefthanded pitchers.

HIT MAN: Brooklyn OF **Jose Medina** currently has a 10-game hitting streak, tied with Batavia's Jerar Encarnacion for the longest active streak in the NYPL... Medina is batting .357 (15-42) over the span...He is the 40th Cyclone to reach double digits for a hitting streak, and the 2nd this season tying OF **Wagner La-grange**, whose streak ended on June 24th.

GET AHEAD: The Cyclones have scored the first run of the game in eight of 11 games this season...Brooklyn is 7-1 in those games.

DOUBLE UP: The Cyclones currently lead the league with a .982 fielding percentage, with just eight errors in 452 total chances...Brooklyn is tied for second in the league with 10 double plays turned.

vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 62-29 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters / Expos...The team is 31-14 in Burlington including 5-1 over the last two seasons...Since 2012, The Cyclones are 27-10 against the Lake Monsters...Since 2001, the Cyclones have lost the season series just three times to Vermont (2009: 2-4, 2011: 1-5, and 2015: 2-4)

NEW KID IN TOWN: RHP **Adam Hill**, the 4th round selection of the Mets in the recent 2018 MLB Draft, has joined the team...The righthander went 7-5 with a 4.12 ERA (38 ER / 83 IP) in 16 games, all starts, with the Gamecocks in 2018...Struck out a career-high 14 batters twice this year, including against Clemson on March 2nd...Finished the year with 101 Ks in 83.0 IP.

ROSTER MOVES: 1B **Dionis Paulino** was transferred to Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League...In addition, RHP **Bryce Montes de Oca** was placed on the Brooklyn Disabled List as of 6/25 and C **Juan Uriarte** was placed on the 60-Day Disabled List.

CORTES IS COMING: Mets 3rd round selection in the 2018 MLB Draft INF **Carlos Cortes** has signed and been assigned to the Cyclones...Cortes, who plays the infield righthanded and outfield lefthanded, hit .265 (61-230) with 53 runs scored, nine doubles and 15 home runs for South Carolina this season.

FOURTH OF JULY: MCU Park and Coney Island will be the center of the "sports" universe on the Fourth of July...ESPN will broadcast the Nathan's Famous Hot Dog Eating Contest on the corner of Surf and Stillwell...Immediately following, MCU Park will hose the American Cornhole League's Pro Invitational featuring some of the top Corhole Players in the world...This will also be broadcast live on ESPN 2...In addition, this weekend MCU Park will host the East Coast Spikeball Tour on Saturday...The event will be taped and rebroadcast on ESPN 2 on the 4th of July.

LAST TIME OUT: Extended his scoreless streak to 11-straight innings to begin his slate with Brooklyn, firing five innings of two-hit ball with eight strikeouts at Connecticut in the Cyclones' 9-1 win.

DOWN FROM ABOVE: Had made four starts this season prior to Saturday, pitching three times for Class-A Columbia and once with Advanced-A St. Lucie...Suffered the tough-luck loss for the Fireflies on June 11 at Lexington, allowing two runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings...Compiled a 1-1 record and a 3.55 ERA with Columbia...Pitched for Advanced-A St. Lucie on April 22, taking the loss...Allowed one run on two hits over four innings, strikout out four and walking three.

LAST SEASON: Went 2-6 with a 2.89 ERA over 13 games and nine starts covering four levels...Pltched for the GCL Mets, King-sport, Brooklyn, and St. Lucie...Tossed a season-high 33.0 innings for the GCL Mets, going 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA over seven games and four starts.

HAVEN'T I SEE YOU BEFORE?: Campusano returns to MCU Park to begin the 2018 season, having pitched twice for Brooklyn in 2017...Faced Lowell (August 31) and Staten Island (September 6) at the end of the season...Compiled a 1.64 ERA, yielding two earned runs over 11.0 innings.

DON'T WALK AWAY FROM ME: For his career, the Dominican has a 6.7% walk rate, having allowed just 42 walks in 154.1 career innings.

STILL COUNTS: Campusano fired a complete-game against Staten Island on September 6, 2017, tossing five innings in a rain-shortened contest...Though the Cyclones lost 2-1, the righthander collected his first-career complete game, striking out seven in the process.
