**LAST NIGHT:** The Hudson Valley Renegades clinched the McNamara Division with a 4-1 win over the Cyclones on Friday night...RHP **Kyle Wilson** (4-4) was tagged with the loss after allowing four runs, earned, on seven hits in 3.2 innings...Brooklyn managed just two hits on the game with C **Nick Meyer's** line drive single the only base knock to leave the infield.

**THREE'S COMPANY:** OF **Ross Adolph** currently leads the NYPL with 11 triples this season...The last player in the NYPL with more than 11 triples was Cyclones OF **Darrell Ceciliani**, who had a franchise-record 12 triples in 2010...Since 2001, when Brooklyn entered the NYPL, the only other player with more triples than Adolph was **Reid Gorecki** (13) of the New Jersey Cardinals in 2002.

**POWER SURGE:** Cyclones pitchers have allowed a New York-Penn League leading 39 home runs this season...Brooklyn allowed a franchise-record 44 home runs last season...The 39 home runs allowed rank third in franchise history (41 - 2004, 44 - 2017).

**A CHILL IN THE AIR:** OF **Ross Adolph** is 0-for-14 over the last three games...OF **Jose Medina** is 3-for-23 over his last six games...C **Nick Meyer** is 4-for-29 in his last nine games with an at-bat.

**TO ERR IS HUMAN:** The Cyclones have committed 14 errors over their last six games and now rank third in the New York-Penn League with a .975 fielding percentage...Brooklyn has 65 errors on the season in 2,639 total chances...Hudson Valley leads the league with just 56 errors and a .979 fielding percentage.

**LEAVE ME HANGING:** The Cyclones are batting .148 (9-61) with runners in scoring position over their last five games...SS **Manny Rodriguez** is batting .172 (11-64) with runners in scoring position this season, with 32 strikeouts in those at-bats.

**vs. STATEN ISLAND:** The Cyclones are 4-5 against Staten Island this season and 114-112 all-time against the Yankees...Brooklyn and Staten Island have not played each other since July 9th...The Cyclones have outscored the Yankees 26-23 this year...The Yankees have hit seven home runs in the nine games this year...Two of the games against the Yankees this year have been started by RHP Noah Syndergaard and LHP Jason Vargas.

**PLAYOFF PICTURE:** Brooklyn currently trails the Auburn Doubledays by 1/2 a game in the race for the NYPL Wild Card...Auburn plays at 1:05 PM on Saturday, so Brooklyn should know the result of their contest before they take the field today...If Brooklyn were to win the Wild Card they would play at MCU Park on Wednesday.

**GET AHEAD:** Brooklyn has scored first in 48 of 72 games this season and is 31-17 in those contests...The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 106-56 in the first two innings of games.

**HOME COOKING:** Brooklyn is 11-4 at MCU Park since the start of August, outscoring teams 85-47.

**A CASE OF THE RUNS:** Brooklyn currently leads the New York-Penn League with 348 runs scored this season...Hudson Valley currently ranks third with 321 runs scored...Cyclones pitchers rank second in the NYPL with just 274 runs allowed.

**INJURY BUG:** OF **Ross Adolph** injured his left foot when he was hit by a pitch in last night's game...He is day-to-day...OF **Jose Medina** left last night's game with a shoulder injury and is also day-to-day...SS **Manny Rodriguez**, who was away from the team, is expected to return today and be in uniform.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Yielded a career-high six runs (two earned) on a career-high-tying seven hits in a no-decision at Vermont...Allowed his first home run of the season, just the fifth in 186.2 IP as a professional to Vermont's Aaron Arruda.

**vs. STATEN ISLAND:** Vilera makes his first start against SI.

**ERA LEADER:** Vilera has the lowest ERA in the NYPL, posting a 1.72 ERA...Had a league-best 0.78 ERA heading into his start at Hudson Valley before allowing four earned runs over 4.1 IP.

**TRIPLE CROWN:** Currently the 21-year-old righthander leads the NYPL in ERA (1.72) and strikeouts (72) and is second in the league with five wins...He is trying to become just the second pitcher since 2001 to win the pitching triple crown, joining former Cyclone RHP **Marcos Molina** who accomplished the feat in 2014.

**STAY HUMBLE, SIT DOWN:** Vilera ranks among NYPL leaders in ERA (1st, 1.72), strikeouts (1st, 72), winning percentage (1st, .833), opponents average (1st, .188), wins (2nd, five), WHIP (1st, 0.94), strikeouts per nine (1st, 9.53), and fewest baserunners (1st, 9.13).

**SUFFOCATING:** Has allowed three hits with runners in scoring position...Opposing batters are 9-for-54 (.167).

**KEEP IT IN THE PARK:** Has only conceded five home runs in 186.2 career innings.
