LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn kept their playoff hopes alive by scoring the first five runs of the game, hanging on to beat Staten Island 5-4 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark on Sunday afternoon...RHPs Billy Oxford (8-1) and Tommy Wilson (SV, 2) combined for 5.2 scoreless relief innings to preserve Brooklyn's lead...2B Angel Manzanarez went 2-4 with a 2B, 2 RBI, and a run.

IT ALL COMES DOWN TO THIS: Brooklyn currently trails the Auburn Doubledays by 1/2-a-game in the race for the NYPL Wild Card...Auburn plays at 1:05 PM today at Batavia...Brooklyn needs to win and Auburn needs to lose for the Cyclones to make the postseason...If Brooklyn was to win the Wild Card, it would play Hudson Valley at MCU Park on Wednesday to start the NYPL Semifinals.

THREE'S COMPANY: OF Ross Adolph currently leads the NYPL with 11 triples this season...The last player in the NYPL with more than 11 triples was Cyclones OF Darrell Ceciliani, who had a franchise-record 12 triples in 2010...Since 2001, when Brooklyn entered the NYPL, the only other player with more triples than Adolph was Reid Gorecki (13) of the New Jersey Cardinals in 2002.

POWER SURGE: Cyclones pitchers rank second in the NYPL with 39 home runs allowed this season... Brooklyn allowed a franchise-record 44 home runs last season...The 39 home runs allowed rank third in franchise history (41 - 2004, 44 - 2017).

A CHILL IN THE AIR: OF Jose Medina is 3-for-23 over his last six games...C Nick Meyer is 4-for-33 in his last ten games with an at-bat...INF Brian Sharp is 2-for-21 (.095) over his last seven games.

GET AHEAD: Brooklyn has scored first in 49 of 74 games this season and is 32-17 in those contests... The Cyclones have outscored their opponents 107-57 in the first two innings of games.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 5-6 against Staten Island this season and 115-113 all-time against the Yankees...Before this series, Brooklyn and Staten Island had not played each other since July 9th...The Cyclones have outscored the Yankees 32-30 this year...The Yankees have hit seven home runs in 11 games this year...Two of the games against the Yankees this year have been started by RHP Noah Syndergaard and LHP Jason Vargas.

TO ERR IS HUMAN: The Cyclones have committed 16 errors over their last eight games and are now tied for second in the New York-Penn League with a .975 fielding percentage...Brooklyn has 67 errors on the season in 2,707 total chances...Staten Island is tied for fourth in the NYPL with a .974 fielding percentage and have also committed 67 errors.

LEAVE ME HANGING: The Cyclones are batting .138 (12-87) with runners in scoring position over their last seven games...Brooklyn went 3-for-16 with RISP in yesterday's win over Staten Island, stranding six runners in scoring position.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn is 11-5 at MCU Park since the start of August, outscoring teams 86-50.

A CASE OF THE RUNS: Brooklyn currently leads the New York-Penn League with 355 runs scored this season...Staten Island ranks second-to-last with 249 runs scored...Cyclones pitchers rank second in the NYPL with just 285 runs allowed, behind only Staten Island's 233 runs allowed.

REHABBING BIG-LEAGUER: New York Mets RHP **Anthony Swarzak** has joined the Cyclones to begin his MLB rehab assignment...The 32-year-old was placed on the 10-day DL on August 14 with right shoulder inflammation...He will become the third Mets pitcher to rehab with Brooklyn this year, joining Noah Syndergaard and Jason Vargas.
