YESTERDAY: The Cyclones lost a tough one on Wednesday night, falling to the Spinners by the score of 3-1...The decisive score came in the top of the seventh, when it appeared the frame would come to a close when Jonathan Diaz was caught stealing. But base umpire Joe Belangia called the runner safe, and on the next pitch Cameron Cannon hit a two-run home run.

IT'S ALL IN THE HITS: Brooklyn pitching has allowed just 269 hits in 377.0 innings this season, fewest in the league...Opponents are batting just .198 this season, tied with Aberdeen for the lowest opponent average in the NYPL.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: During the month of July, **Wilmer Reyes** ranked second in the NYPL with a .352 average and ranked fourth in the league in slugging (.484)...Reyes was tied for third in hits (32)...Tonight's starter, RHP **Garrison Bryant**, ranked third in the NYPL with a 1.55 ERA during the month of July.

RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT: Brooklyn ranks first in the New York-Penn League with a .279 (100-359) batting average and a .426 slugging percentage with runners in scoring position...Brooklyn is batting .288 with RISP and two outs, best in the league...West Virginia ranks second (.273).

SWIPING RIGHT: The Cyclones stole 43 bases in 57 attempts during the month of July, ranking second-most in the New York-Penn League...Brooklyn stole just eight in June...INF **Wilmer Reyes** and **Jake Mangum** stole six bases each during the month.

ROAD SWEET ROAD: Brooklyn is currently 11-12 at home and 14-7 on the road...Brooklyn has outscored opponents 89-63 on the road and been outscored 96-91 at home.

vs. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 59-48 all-time against the Lowell Spinners, including 34-25 at MCU Park and 25-23 at LeLacheur Park...The Cyclones are 10-6 against the Spinners at home over the last three seasons...Brooklyn took two of three from Lowell at MCU Park earlier this season and split a pair in Lowell.

GARRISON THE GREAT: Since July 9th, RHP **Garrison Bryant** has tossed 24.0 innings, allowing just three runs on 12 hits with 19 strikeouts and five walks...He has not allowed more than one run in any of his four starts over the span.

WHAT'S GLOVE GOT TO DO: The Cyclones currently rank third in the NYPL with a .973 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 43 errors in 1,584 total chances.

DON'T WALK: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with just 111 walks...INF **Wilmer Reyes** has just four walks in 130 plate appearances, and OF **Antoine Duplantis** has just three walks in 111 plate appearances...There is only one player on the Cyclones roster with more than 10 walks on the year (Ritter - 21)...There are 71 players in the NYPL with at least 11 walks, and only one of them plays for Brooklyn.

ROSTER MOVE: OF **Kennie Taylor** was transferred from Kingsport, where he hit .281 (34-121) with two home runs and 10 RBI in 29 games. Taylor, out of Duke, was the Mets' 14th-round draft pick this year...OF **Anthony Dirocie** was transferred to Kingsport.

LITTLE LEAGUE BOUND: Brooklyn heads to Williamsport, Pennsylvania for the weekend, playing the CrossCutters, the affiliate of the Phillies, Friday through Sunday...Brooklyn faces the Philadelphia affiliate on the road for the first time since 2016.

LAST TIME OUT: For the second straight outing, tossed a career-high seven innings, allowing just one run on one hit and one walk...Despite going seven strong, took a no-decision in Brooklyn's 2-1, 10-inning win at Vermont on Friday.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Bryant ranks fourth in the league in batting average against (.187), fifth in WHIP (0.98), ninth in innings (42.0), and tied for tenth in strikeouts (41).

YA SNOOZE, YA LOSE: The NYPL has had success on Bryant's first pitch, hitting 13-36 (.361) in a 0-0 count...In any other count, the NYPL is batting 16-119 (.134) against him.

DO-OVER: Spent 2018 in Kingsport for the second consecutive season...Went 1-3 with a 5.24 ERA in 11 games and eight starts last season, making drastic improvements in the Appalachian League when he was 0-5 with a 8.76 ERA in 12 games in 2017.

WOULD-BE QB: Committed to play quarterback at New Mexico Military Institute prior to conversations with the Mets.

I'LL TAKE A SHIRLEY TEMPLE: Bryant is just 20 years old, looking forward to his 21st birthday in December...Drafted out of high school in 2016 at the age of 17.

BOSTON STRONG: Born in New England, the Deerfield, New Hampshire native is a strong Boston sports fan...Loves the Patriots, Red Sox, and Bruins...Since he was born in December of 1998, Garrison has enjoyed 12 professional championships...Eli Manning and the New York Giants have also defeated the Patriots twice in the Super Bowl, leaving Bryant without two potential titles in his short lifetime.
