**YESTERDAY:** Brooklyn won a pair from the Tri-City ValleyCats on Sunday, winning Saturday's suspended game by the score of 2-1 before walking off with a 5-3 win in the nightcap...In Game Two, INF **Yoel Romero** had a two-run blast in the bottom of the eighth to give the Cyclones the walk-off win in extra innings as the game was scheduled for seven frames.

**RARE AIR FOR ROMERO:** The walk-off home run from INF **Yoel Romero** was only the tenth game-ending dinger in franchise history and the first since DH **Walter Rasquin** hit a solo home run in extra innings of a doubleheader against Lowell on August 31, 2017 to give Brooklyn a 3-2 win...The Cyclones had five walk-off home runs during the 2010 and 2011 seasons, but had just three prior to that.

**LEFT HANGING:** The Cyclones are just 9-51 (.176) with RISP over their last six games...Brooklyn is just 2-for-15 with RISP during this series with Tri-City...Despite the recent struggles, Brooklyn still leads the NYPL with a .272 (140-515) average with RISP.

**WIN SOME, LOSE SOME:** The Cyclones are 1-7 in their last eight road games...Brooklyn is 8-1 in their last nine home games over that same stretch.

**THE SINGLE LIFE:** Brooklyn ranks sixth in the New York-Penn League with 474 hits on the year, but 73.8% of their hits have been singles...Brooklyn ranks tied for 12th in the NYPL with 79 doubles.

**DON'T WALK:** The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with just 161 walks, 91 behind the league-leading West Virginia Black Bears (252)...There are seven teams in the NYPL with at least 50 more walks than the Cyclones...INF **Luke Ritter** is tied for fourth in the league with 30 walks...No other player on the team has more than 14 walks (Yoel Romero).

**vs. TRI-CITY:** The Cyclones are 51-44 all-time against the Tri-City ValleyCats...Brooklyn took 2-of-3 from the 'Cats at MCU Park earlier this season but lost 2-of-3 on the road...With the two wins yesterday, Brooklyn assured themselves of winning the season series against the ValleyCats for the first time since 2010...The Cyclones split the series in 2013 and 2016.

**HOME COOKIN':** Brooklyn is 19-13 at MCU Park and has outscored opponent 130-113 at home...Brooklyn is batting .237 as a team, while opponents are batting just .202...2B **Luke Ritter** is batting .333 (27-81) with 15 runs scored and three home runs at home.

**THE COUNTDOWN:** Cyclones manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** currently has 98 wins as manager of the Cyclones...Fonzie is hoping to become the fourth manager in franchise history to eclipse the 100-win plateau, joining his brother **Edgar Alfonzo** (146), **Rich Donnelly** (128), and **Tom Gamboa** (112).

**RING THE BELL:** Cyclones manager **Edgardo Alfonzo** will be ringing the closing bell at the New York Stock Exchange on Tuesday as part of the New York-Penn League All-Star Game Ceremonies...The NYPL ASG will be played Wednesday night at Staten Island...The Brooklyn staff will be coaching the Blue Team.

**WINTER FOR WILMER:** Cyclones All-Star INF **Wilmer Reyes** is currently 0-for-17 dating to August 13th and has struck out in seven of those at-bats...Prior to this slump, Reyes hadn't gone back-to-back games without a hit since an 0-for-9 stretch from June 22 - 27.

**GAVIN GA-REAT:** Since July 15th, spanning 16 games with an at-bat, INF **Gavin Garay** is batting .333 (17-51) with four doubles and a home run...Garay currently has a seven-game hitting streak.

**FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING:** In his last outing at Vermont, Jones allowed his first hits, runs, and home run as a pro...Also took his first pro loss.

**HE'S BAAAACK:** Missed a month and a half with illness... Made his first pro start on June 17 against Aberdeen (4th game of the season), but didn't pitch again until Saturday, August 3 at Williamsport (47th game of the season).

**FIRST IN LINE:** Was the first 2019 Mets draft selection to make a pro start for Brooklyn when he pitched against Aberdeen on June 17.

**NORTHWESTERN STATE:** Second-highest draft selection out of Northwestern State University in Louisiana...Highest pick since Mason Melotakis (2nd, 2012) by Minnesota.

**STRAIGHT OUTTA THE SOUTHLAND:** Earned Second Team All-Southland honors in 2019, going 7-4 with a 2.78 ERA...Finished top 10 in the Southland Conference in eight categories, including wins (7), Ks (80), and opponents' average (.209)...Only Southland pitcher to throw multiple complete-game shutouts in 2019, doing so in back-to-back starts.

**SISTER, SISTER:** Jones has five siblings, including a sister named Brooklyn.
