YESTERDAY: The Cyclones squandered a 5-2 lead, allowing two runs in the eighth and two more in the ninth as Connecticut won the series finale 6-5 in walkoff fashion...RHP **Matt Mullenbach** walked three batters, including a walk with the bases loaded to give the Tigers the win...3B **Jose Peroza** hit a three-run home run to pace the Brooklyn bats.

CENTURY CLUB: With Brooklyn's win in Game One of Friday's double header, **Edgardo Alfonzo** won his 100th game as the manager of the Cyclones...Fonzie became the fourth manager in franchise history to eclipse the 100-win mark...He now ranks fourth all-time with 101 career Cyclones wins, trailing his brother **Edgar Alfonzo** (146), **Rich Donnelly** (128), and **Tom Gamboa** (112).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: The Cyclones are 9-1 in their last 10 home games and lead the league with a 20-13 record at MCU Park.

WHO'S HOT: OF **Jake Mangum** is batting .305 (18-59) in 20 games during the month of August with a .406 on-base percentage...1B **Gavin Garay** is batting .306 (11-36) with four doubles, one home run and three RBI in 11 games during the month.

WHO'S NOT: OF **Antoine Duplantis** is hitting .179 (10-56) in 17 games during August...He currently has just one hit since August 16th - spanning six games...1B **Joe Genord** has a .138 (8-58) average for the month...C **Jake Ortega** is hitting .139 (5-36) in 12 August games and is just 3 for his last 25.

THE K IN LAKE MONSTERS: Vermont comes into tonight's game leading the NYPL with 639 strikeouts as a team...Vermont has 2180 at-bats as a team and has struck out in 29.3% of them...Lawrence Butler leads the league with 76 strikeouts in 171 at-bats and Kyle McCann ranks second with 73 k's in 184 at-bats.

vs. VERMONT: Brooklyn is 69-36 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters / Expos...The Cyclones are 33-15 at MCU Park against Vermont and have not lost a home series against the Monsters since 2011...Brooklyn has lost just three series at home to Vermont all-time...Brooklyn was swept in a three-game series in Burlington earlier this month...Vermont has never won four straight against BKLYN.

PITCHING IN: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed just 12 runs over their last eight games and have allowed one run or less in six of these eight games.

THE SINGLE LIFE: Brooklyn is seventh in the New York-Penn League with 500 hits on the year, but 73.8% of their hits have been singles...Brooklyn ranks 13th in the NYPL with 82 doubles.

RACE TO THE FINISH: The Cyclones enter Sunday's game tied with Aberdeen for 1st place in the Wild Card, with West Virginia and Staten Island one game back...Brooklyn is tied for second in the McNamara Division and trails Hudson Valley by one game.

ROSTER MOVE: RHP **Christian Tripp** has joined the Cyclones from the Kingsport Mets...Tripp began the year with the Columbia Fireflies, where he went 0-0 with a 15.00 ERA in six games but has not pitched since July 2nd due to injury...Tripp was selected in the 13th round of the 2018 MLB Draft and went 2-0 with a 4.05 ERA in 15 games with the K-Mets last season.

NEW THREADS: The Cyclones will take the field as the Brooklyn Amazins today as they celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the 1969 World Series Champions...The jerseys will be auctioned off through the Live Source App.

ALL-STAR: Named to the New York-Penn League's all-star roster, receiving the first all-star honors of his four-year career...Earned the victory Wednesday at Staten Island, tossing one scoreless inning with one strikeout.

THE MAN WAS ON A RUN: Had allowed three earned runs over five starts between July 14 and August 5, amassing 27.1 innings during the span...The span included strong starts against division leaders like Hudson Valley and Lowell.

2018 SEASON: Pitched with Kingsport (R) last season, working as a starting pitcher...Went 1-4 with a 4.97 ERA over 10 starts, walking 40 batters and striking out just 26.

WINDSOR TIES TO BROOKLYN: Cleveland is the second professional player from Windsor, joining Dick Teed...Teed played 17 seasons in the pros, making one appearance in the Major Leagues...Teed pinch hit in one game for the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1953, striking out against the Milwaukee Braves on July 24...He was sent down, playing 10 more seasons in the minors without earning another call-up.

FARM FAMILY: Played for head coach Joe Serfass at Windsor High School...Serfass played in the Mets farm system from 2004-2007, reaching as high as Double-A Binghamton, but never played for the Cyclones.
