YESTERDAY: Vermont scored on a wild pitch and held on to beat Brooklyn 3-2 in 10 innings Tuesday night, despite the Cyclones' two-out rally to tie the game in the ninth on Gavin Garay's RBI double... Garay finished 3-4 and INF Wilmer Reyes went 2-4 with an RBI...RHP Frank Valentino struck out a Cyclones-high eight batters over 5 1/3 innings.

PLAYOFF PUSH: Brooklyn seeks its first playoff berth since 2012, entering Wednesday's contest tied with Aberdeen for the Wild Card spot...Both the Cyclones and IronBirds are one game behind first-place Hudson Valley in the McNamara Division...Staten Island sits 2.5 games behind Hudson Valley and 1.5 games behind the Wild Card spot.

FREE WILLY: INF **Wilmer Reyes** has produced a career-high 29 RBIs this season, tallying six over his past six games...The Dominican utility infielder surpassed his career-high of 26 RBIs with the DSL Mets in 2017...Reyes ranks fourth in the league in hits (66), fifth in batting (.322), eighth in total bases (91), an 10th in slugging (.444).

WHO'S HOT: OF **Jake Mangum** is batting .302 (19-63) in 21 games during the month of August with a .405 on-base percentage...1B **Gavin Garay** is batting .350 (14-40) with five doubles, one home run, and four RBIs in 12 games during the month...OF **Ranfy Adon** is hitting .350 (21-60) since July 9th and has hit safely in 14 of 19 games.

WHO'S NOT: 1B **Joe Genord** has a .134 (9-67) average for the month...C **Jake Ortega** is hitting .139 (5-36) in 12 August games and is just 3 for his last 25...OF **Raul Beracierta** is just 3-for-27 over his last 14 games, dating to July 30th.

HIGH WATER: With Monday's win, Brooklyn moved to 10 games over .500 for the first time since the final game of the 2012 season.

vs. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 102-77 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 48-45 at MCU Park...Brooklyn is 4-4 against Aberdeen this season, splitting a two-game series and dishing out and receiving a three-game sweep...Brooklyn hasn't won the season series against Aberdeen since 2016...The IronBirds have been in the NYPL since 2002.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: The Cyclones are 11-2 at home in August and lead the league with a 22-14 record at MCU Park...Brooklyn is batting .242 at home, and opponents are batting just .201...The Cyclones have outscored opponents 151-119 in Brooklyn...C **Jose Mena** is batting .368 (21-57) in 19 home games, and OF **Kennie Taylor** is batting .278 (10-36) at home with two doubles, two triples, two home runs, and seven RBIs.

GARRISON THE GREAT: RHP **Garrison Bryant**, is 4-0 with a 0.86 ERA in nine games, dating back to July 9th...The right-hander has not allowed more than one run in any of these outings, and opponents are batting just .140 (25-178) against him over this span...Garrison leads all of MiLB, and ranks second in all of professional baseball, with his 0.86 ERA since July 9th...Only Jack Flaherty of the St. Louis Cardinals (0.73 ERA) has a better ERA over this span (4 ER / 49.1 IP).

PITCHING IN: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed just 18 runs over their last 11 games and have allowed one run or less in seven of these 11 games.

ROUGH ROAD: Brooklyn began the season 14-7 on the road...Since August 1, the Cyclones are just 3-9, suffering sweeps to Williamsport and Vermont, two teams under .500.

LAST TIME OUT: Yielded one hit to 17 total batters faced over 4 1/3 innings at Connecticut Friday evening...Otanez struck out three and walked three in a no-decision en route to a 4-0 Cyclones victory over the Tigers.

TOP OF THE TOP: Otañez ranks as the 26th-best prospect in the Mets farm system, according to the recent re-ranking by *Baseball America*.

K, BYE: Otañez has struck out 120 in 114.2 career innings, including 44 strikeouts in 32.2 innings with Kingsport this season...His 2019 K% is 27%...Fanned a season-high eight batters on three separate occasions with the K-Mets.

KINGSPORT RESUME: Struck out 44 over 32.2 innings with 11 walks to the tune of a 2-2 record and 3.31 ERA...The Appalachian League hit just .218 against him, homering one time.

THIRD PRO SEASON: Signed and assigned to the DSL Mets in 2016, pitching 21.1 innings over five starts, striking out 21... Did not pitch in 2017...Spent the full 2018 season with the GCL Mets, going 1-6 with a 7.64 earned run average.

HOME SWEET HOME: Hails from Villa La Mata, the center of the Dominican Republic with a total population of 42,000... Grew up 15 minutes north of Cotui, the home of Brooklyn catcher Jose Mena.

- Brooklyn arms have combined for 73 wild pitches, third-most in the league behind Tri-City's 94 and Mahoning Valley's 74...45 of those have come with runners in scoring position, second-most in the NYPL behind Tri-City's 61.
- RHP Jared Biddy has allowed one earned run over 24 innings, posting a 0.38 ERA...He has fanned 31 of 90 batters, good for a 34% K-rate.
