**YESTERDAY:** The Cyclones jumped out to leads of 7-0 and 8-3, but needed an 8th inning RBI single from OF **Jake Mangum** to hold on for a 9-8 win over the IronBirds on Wednesday night...INF **Wilmer Reyes** went 3-for-5 and 2B **Luke Ritter** added a 2-for-3 effort with three runs scored...Four different Cyclones had multi-hit efforts.

**PLAYOFF PUSH:** Brooklyn seeks its first playoff berth since 2012, entering Thursday's contest tied with Hudson Valley for the McNamara Division lead and 1.0 game ahead of Aberdeen for the division and the Wild Card...Staten Island sits 1.5 games behind for the division and wild card.

**FREE WILLY:** INF **Wilmer Reyes** currently has a seven game hitting streak since...Since returning from the All-Star Break, Reyes is batting .462 (12-26) with six runs scored and six RBI over the seven game stretch.

**HE'S GARRRRRAY-T:** Brooklyn 1B **Gavin Garay** began the year 1-for-27 over his first nine games with an at-bat...Since July 15th, Garay is batting .353 (24-68) over 21 games and has hit safely in 15 of these contests.

**SKIN OF THEIR TEETH:** Brooklyn improved to 16-14 in one runs games following last night's 9-8 win...The 16 wins are tied with the Staten Island Yankees for most one-run games in the NYPL.

**NO PLACE LIKE HOME:** The Cyclones are 11-2 at home in August and lead the league with a 22-14 record at MCU Park...Brooklyn is batting .242 at home, and opponents are batting just .201...The Cyclones have outscored opponents 151-119 in Brooklyn...C **Jose Mena** is batting .368 (21-57) in 19 home games, and OF **Kennie Taylor** is batting .278 (10-36) at home with two doubles, two triples, two home runs, and seven RBIs.

**vs. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones are 103-77 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 49-45 at MCU Park...Brooklyn is 5-4 against Aberdeen this season, splitting a two-game series and dishing out and receiving a three-game sweep...Brooklyn hasn't won the season series against Aberdeen since 2016...The IronBirds have been in the NYPL since 2002.

**WHO'S THAT GUY:** With the Kingsport Mets and GCL Mets seasons coming to an end, the Cyclones have added several new faces to the roster prior to Thursday's game...INF **Brett Baty** and RHP **Reyson Santos** join the team from Kingsport and OF **Kenedy Corona** and RHP **Matthew Allan** join Brooklyn from the GCL Mets.

**A BUNCH ON BATY:** 3B **Brett Baty** - who was selected 12th overall in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Lake Travis HS in Texas - joins the team from the K-Mets where he hit .357 (15-42) with four doubles, one triple and two home runs over his last 10 games...Baty becomes the 15th first round selection to play for Brooklyn and is tied for the 2nd highest selection to ever play for Brooklyn behind OF **Michael Conforto** (10th overall, 2014).

**ALL-IN ON ALLAN:** RHP **Matthew Allan**, who was considered the 13th overall prospect in the 2019 MLB Draft by MLB Pipeline, will join the Cyclones after beginning his pro career with the GCL Mets...The 18-year-old is expected to pitch for Brooklyn on Saturday after going 1-0 with a 1.08 ERA with the GCL Mets...Allan struck out 11 and allowed just five hits over 8.1 innings.

**ROUGH ROAD:** Brooklyn began the season 14-7 on the road...Since August 1, the Cyclones are just 4-9, suffering sweeps to Williamsport and Vermont, two teams under .500.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Yielded a two-run home run to Connecticut catcher Eliezer Alfonzo in the third inning that tied the game in a 6-5 Tigers victory...Jones tossed three innings for the second time as a professional, striking out three and walking one.

**HOME RUNS:** Of the four runs allowed by Jones in 13 inning this season, each has come via a pair of two-run home runs (Vermont's Marty Bechina on August 14 and Connecticut's Eliezer Alfonzo on August 24).

**HE'S BAAAACK:** Missed a month and a half with illness... Made his first pro start on June 17 against Aberdeen (4th game of the season), but didn't pitch again until Saturday, August 3 at Williamsport (47th game of the season).

**NORTHWESTERN STATE:** Second-highest draft selection out of Northwestern State University in Louisiana...Highest pick since Mason Melotakis (2nd, 2012) by Minnesota.

**STRAIGHT OUTTA THE SOUTHLAND:** Earned Second Team All-Southland honors in 2019, going 7-4 with a 2.78 ERA...Finished top 10 in the Southland Conference in eight categories, including wins (7), Ks (80), and opponents' average (.209)...Only Southland pitcher to throw multiple complete-game shutouts in 2019, doing so in back-to-back starts.

**SISTER, SISTER:** Jones has five siblings, including a sister named Brooklyn.

- Brooklyn arms have combined for 74 wild pitches, tied for second-most in the league with Mahoning Valley, 20 behind Tri-City's 94...45 of those have come with runners in scoring position, second-most in the NYPL behind Tri-City's 61.
- RHP Jared Bidy has allowed one earned run over 24 innings, posting a 0.38 ERA...He has fanned 31 of 90 batters, good for a 34% K-rate.
