YESTERDAY: The Cyclones were shut out in a nine-inning game for the first time this season, losing 1-0 to Williamsport in the opener of a three-game series...RHP **Michel Otanez** took the tough-luck loss, allowing one unearned run over 5 1/3 innings, while IF **Joe Genord** doubled for the team's only extra-base hit of the night.

IT'S ALL IN THE HITS: Brooklyn pitching has allowed just 280 hits in 394.0 innings this season, fewest in the league...Opponents are batting just .198 this season, the lowest opponent average in the NYPL.

REYES IS RAKING: INF **Wilmer Reyes** snapped his 12-game hitting streak during which he is batted .383 (18-47) with two doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI...Since June 28th, Reyes is batting .355 (38-107) and has hit safely in 24 of 28 contests...Reyes ranks fifth among qualified players in the NYPL with a .393 wOBA and 150 wRC+.

RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT: Brooklyn ranks first in the New York-Penn League with a .276 (102-369) batting average with runners in scoring position, West Virginia ranks second (.268)...Brooklyn is batting .283 with RISP and two outs, best in the league.

SWIPING RIGHT: The Cyclones stole 43 bases in 57 attempts during the month of July, ranking second-most in the New York-Penn League...Brooklyn stole just eight in June...INF **Wilmer Reyes** and **Jake Mangum** stole six bases each during the month.

ROAD SWEET ROAD: Brooklyn is currently 12-12 at home and 14-8 on the road...Brooklyn has out scored opponents 89-64 on the road and has matched up 97-97 for home games.

vs. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones are 47-30 all-time against the Williamsport Crosscutters including a 20-15 mark at BB&T Ballpark...Brooklyn has not played in Williamsport since 2016...The Cyclones are 10-3 against the 'Cutters since 2014...Brooklyn and Williamsport played in the NYPL Championship Series in 2001 prior to the September 11th attacks ending the season.

WHAT'S GLOVE GOT TO DO WITH IT: The Cyclones currently rank third in the NYPL with a .973 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 44 errors in 1,662 total chances.

DON'T WALK: The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with just 115 walks in 1633 plate appearances...INF **Wilmer Reyes** has just four walks in 137 plate appearances, and OF **Antoine Duplantis** has just three walks in 119 plate appearances...INF **Luke Ritter** has walked 22 times, tied for fourth most in the league, to account for 19% of the team's total walks.

ROAD RULES: INF **Yoel Romero** is batting .339 (20-59) on the road and .213 (10-47) at home...1B **Joe Genord** is hitting .323 (21-65) as the visitor and .130 (9-69) at MCU Park.

LUKE AT A LOSS: INF **Luke Ritter** is just 2-for-19 over his last six games and hasn't had a multi-hit game since July 14th vs. West Virginia...Since July 15th, Ritter is batting .173 (9-52) with a .295 on-base percentage thanks to six walks and three HBP.

J-O'fer: INF **Joe Genord** is batting just .125 (8-64) since July 8th and has just one multi-hit game in 22 contests over this span...For the season, Genord has at least one strikeout in 33 of his 39 games with an at-bat.

NATHAN NEAR NATHAN'S: Jones makes his second professional start today against Williamsport...He was the first 2019 Mets draft selection to make a pro start when he pitched against Aberdeen on June 17.

NORTHWESTERN STATE: Second-highest draft selection out of Northwestern State University in Louisiana...highest pick since Mason Melotakis (2nd, 2012) by Minnesota... Melotakis reached as high as Triple-A.

STRAIGHT OUTTA THE SOUTHLAND: Earned Second Team All-Southland honors in 2019, going 7-4 with a 2.78 ERA...Finished among the top 10 in the Southland Conference in eight different categories, including wins (7), strikeouts (80), and batting average against (.209)...Only conference pitcher to throw multiple complete-game shutouts this spring, doing so against McNeese and Stephen F. Austin in back-to-back starts.

SISTER, SISTER: Jones has five siblings, including a sister named Brooklyn.
