**YESTERDAY:** For the second straight game, the Cyclones blew a late-game lead and fell to the Williamsport Crosscutters 4-3 at BB&T Ballpark... Brooklyn led 3-0 in the 8th, but the 'Cutters scored three in the eighth and one in the ninth to walk off with a win...RHP **Frank Valentino** tossed 6.0 shutout frames, allowing just one hit...INF **Luke Ritter** went 2-for-4 with a pair of RBI to pace the Brooklyn bats.

**HIT THE SKIDS:** The Cyclones are 1-6 over their last seven games...Brooklyn is batting just .197 (41-208) over this span and has scored just 18 runs.

**REYES IS RAKING:** Since June 28th, INF Wilmer Reyes is batting .365 (42-115) with 18 runs scored and 19 RBI in the 30 games over this span...Reyes has not had consecutive hitless games over this span and has hit safely in 27 of 30 games.

**RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT:** Brooklyn ranks first in the New York-Penn League with a .271 (106-391) batting average with runners in scoring position, Lowell ranks second (.260)...Brooklyn is batting .277 with RISP and two outs, best in the league.

**ON THE WILD SIDE:** The Cyclones have 53 wild pitches, second most in the NYPL (Tri-City-66)... Brooklyn has allowed 10 runs to score thanks to a wild pitch this season.

**HOME COOKIN':** OF **Antoine Duplantis** is batting .308 (16-52) at MCU Park and .167 (11-66) on the road...INF **Luke Ritter** is batting .356 (21-59) at home and .179 (15-84) away from Brooklyn.

**WHAT'S GLOVE GOT TO DO WITH IT:** The Cyclones currently rank third in the NYPL with a .974 fielding percentage...The team has been charged with 45 errors in 1,726 total chances.

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones are 101-88 against the Renegades all-time including 4-2 this season...The Renegades are one of three teams that Brooklyn has reached 100 wins against (Aberdeen & Staten Island)...Brooklyn is 55-39 against the Renegades at home, but tonight will mark their first home game against the 'Gades this season.

**DON'T WALK:** The Cyclones rank last in the NYPL with just 120 walks in 1,709 plate appearances...INF **Wilmer Reyes** has just four walks in 145 plate appearances, and OF **Antoine Duplantis** has just three walks in 124 plate appearances...INF **Luke Ritter** has walked 22 times, tied for fourth most in the league, to account for 19% of the team's total walks.

**J-O'fer:** INF **Joe Genord** is batting just .114 (8-70) since July 8th and has just one multi-hit game in 24 contests over this span...Genord is currently in the middle of a 1-for-24 stretch over his last six games... He has hit safely in just seven of his last 23 games with an AB.

**A CASE OF THE MONDAYS:** The Cyclones are batting .194 (34-124) on Monday games and have scored just 13 runs in four Monday contests.

**WHAT'S ON TAP:** The Cyclones open up a six-game homestand tonight with MLB Network Night... Mark DeRosa and Eric Byrnes will host a "Sandlot to the Show" clinic at the ballpark pre-game...In addition, all kids 12 & under will get an MLB Network mini-bat and can eat for free...Tuesday is a special 11:30 AM start for Camp Day...Wednesday night is a Way Back Wednesday with an appearance from Corbin Bernsen, who played the role of Roger Dorn in the "Major League" films...He will be signing autographs, and there is a limited-edition bobblehead available through a package.
