YESTERDAY: The Cyclones dropped the rubber-game of a three-game set in Troy, NY to the ValleyCats, 6-5 on Tuesday afternoon...Brooklyn scored twice with two outs in the ninth, thanks to back-to-back doubles from **Jake Mangum** and **Branden Fryman**, but a two run home run in the bottom of the 10th gave the ValleyCats a walk-off win.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: INF **Joe Genord** was named the New York-Penn League Batter of the Week for the period of July 1 - July 7...Genord hit .333 with five runs scored, three doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI over this stretch...Only two players in all of MiLB had more RBI than Genord over this span...Genord is the first Cyclone to win Batter of the Week since Jose Medina in July, 2017...He is the 11th Cyclone to win the award...27 Cyclones pitchers have been honored with Pitcher of the Week.

RUT-ROH ROMERO: INF **Yoel Romero** left Tuesday's game with a lower body injury and is considered day-to-day...Romero is currently fourth in the NYPL with a .321 average, 5th in slugging (.500) and sixth in OPS (.869)

DIRTY DOZEN: INF **Yoel Romero** currently has a 12-game hitting streak, tied for the longest streak in the NYPL this season...Romero's streak is the 20th streak of 12 or more in franchise history and the longest since Walter Rasquin hit in 14 straight games during the 2017 season...The franchise record is 17 games by **Lucas Duda** from August 16, 2007 - September 2, 2007.

NAIL-BITING: The Cyclones have played 13 one-run games, going 8-5 in those contests...The Cyclones have been outscored by 15 runs this season...In wins, Brooklyn is +21 in run differential, but -36 in losses.

vs. MAHONING VALLEY: The Cyclones are 29-27 all-time against the Mahoning Valley Scrappers, including 13-11 here at MCU Park...The Cyclones have gone just 2-4 at MCU Park against Mahoning Valley since 2011...The first game ever played at MCU Park (then KeySpan Park) was between the Scrappers and Cyclones on June 25, 2001, a game Brooklyn won 3-2 in 10 innings.

ROSTER MOVES: OF **Zach Rheams** has rejoined the Cyclones after going 2-13 with the Columbia Fireflies in four games in the SAL after being transferred from Brooklyn on July 2nd...INF **Angel Manzanarez** has also rejoined the club after being transferred to Kingsport (R) of the Appy League, but did not appear in a game with them.

OFF PITCH: Over their last seven games, Brooklyn is 2-5, tied for the worst record in the NYPL...The team has a 4.42 ERA (29 ER / 59.0 IP), second worst in the league, and has allowed a league-high seven home runs over this span.

REYES IS RAKING: INF **Wilmer Reyes** has hit safely in seven straight games, including three consecutive multi-hit games...Since June 28th, Reyes is batting a whopping .519 (14-27)...During the month of July, Reyes is batting .500 (9-18) and the rest of the Cyclones are batting .231 (66-286).

DON'T CROSS THE STREAMS: The Cyclones will be the first - and only - team in Minor League Baseball who will stream games through Facebook Live this season...Brooklyn will stream all 38 home games exclusively through Facebook Live as part of a partnership with Sling Studio...All other MiLB teams that offer streaming must use MiLB TV...Recently Brooklyn had 27,000+ viewers watch the Cyclones take on the Aberdeen IronBirds.

FAMILIAR FREEDOM FACES: Becomes the fourth Freedom player since 2017 to have their contract purchased by the Mets...Joins infielder Jose Brizuela and pitchers Matt Pobereyko and Marty Anderson...Brizuela played 28 games for Brooklyn last year, and Anderson made four outings for Brooklyn in 2017.
