LAST GAME: Brooklyn defeated the Scrappers 9-0 on Wednesday night...RHP **Frank Valentino** (1-1) tossed 6.0 shutout frames, allowing just two hits and a walk while striking out seven...INF **Branden Fryman** went 4-for-5 with two runs scored, two RBIs and two stolen bases.

RUT-ROH ROMERO: INF **Yoel Romero** left Tuesday's game with a lower body injury and is considered day-to-day...Romero is currently fourth in the NYPL in batting average (.321) and slugging percentage (.500)...He's also seventh in OPS (.869).

DIRTY DOZEN: INF **Yoel Romero** currently has a 12-game hitting streak, tied for the longest streak in the NYPL this season....Romero's streak is the 20th streak of 12 or more in franchise history and the longest since Walter Rasquin hit in 14 straight games during the 2017 season...The franchise record is 17 games by **Lucas Duda** from August 16, 2007 - September 2, 2007.

NAIL-BITING: The Cyclones have played 13 one-run games, going 8-5 in those contests...The Cyclones have been outscored by 6 runs this season...In wins, Brooklyn is +30 in run differential, but -36 in losses.

ROSTER MOVES: OF **Zach Rheams** has rejoined the Cyclones after going 2-13 over four games with the Columbia Fireflies (A), where he was transferred from Brooklyn on July 2nd...INF **Angel Manzanarez** has also rejoined the club after being transferred to Kingsport (R) of the Appy League, but did not appear in a game with them...LHP **P.J. Conlon** has joined the team on rehab.

REYES IS RAKING: INF **Wilmer Reyes** has hit safely in eight straight games...Since June 28th, Reyes is batting a whopping .469 (15-32)...During the month of July, Reyes is batting .435 (10-23).

vs. MAHONING VALLEY: The Cyclones are 30-27 all-time against the Mahoning Valley Scrappers, including 14-11 here at MCU Park...The Cyclones have gone just 3-4 at MCU Park against Mahoning Valley since 2011...The first game ever played at MCU Park (then KeySpan Park) was between the Scrappers and Cyclones on June 25, 2001, a game Brooklyn won 3-2 in 10 innings.

THE NEED FOR SPEED: The Cyclones have stolen 20 bases in 25 attempts during the month of July, 2nd-most in the New York-Penn League...The only other team in the league with more than 12 swipes this month is Hudson Valley, who leads the way with 27 stolen bases in July.

RISP, REWARD: Brooklyn leads the New York-Penn League with a .280 (58-207) average with runners in scoring position...However, Brooklyn has had 207 at-bats with RISP, the second-least in the league and an average of 8.3 per game...There are six players on the Cyclones roster with at least 10 at-bats with runners in scoring position. Five of the six are hitting at least .286, with INFs **Joe Genord**, **Wilmer Reyes**, **Luke Ritter**, and **Yoel Romero** all hitting over .300...OF **Antoine Duplantis** is 0-11 with RISP.

DON'T WALK: Brooklyn ranks last in the NYPL with just 62 walks this season, 11 less than any other team...State College leads the way with 122 free passes...INF **Luke Ritter** is tied for fourth in the league with 14 walks this season, but no other player on the team has more than six walks.

DON'T CROSS THE STREAMS: The Cyclones will be the first - and only - team in Minor League Baseball who will stream games through Facebook Live this season...Brooklyn will stream all 38 home games exclusively through Facebook Live as part of a partnership with Sling Studio...All other MiLB teams that offer streaming must use MiLB TV.
