**LAST NIGHT:** Behind an early lead, reliever **Matt Mullenbach** and the Cyclones bullpen held onto a 4-2 victory in the rubber game at Hudson Valley to move into first place in the McNamara Division... Mullenbach escaped a bases-loaded, no-out jam in the eighth, striking out three consecutive batters.

**WHO'S HOT:** Brooklyn infielder **Wilmer Reyes** is batting .340 (17-50) during the month of July...SS **Branden Fryman** is batting .349 (15-43) since being transferred to Brooklyn from the GCL Mets.

**WHO'S NOT:** INF **Joe Genord** is currently 1-for-29 over his last nine games with an at-bat... Over this span, he also has with 14 strikeouts...Genord's batting average has dropped from .297 to .232 over this stretch.

**SILENT ASSASIN:** RHP Matt Mullenbach had ice in his veins last night, stranding the bases loaded with nobody out...He has stranded all eight of the runners he has inherited, posting a 1.74 ERA...The undrafted righty out of Lincoln Memorial University (DI) in Tennessee has posted scoreless outings in seven of eight.

**RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT:** Brooklyn ranks first in the New York-Penn League with a .285 (75-263) batting average with runners in scoring position.

**SWIPING RIGHT:** The Cyclones have stolen 31 bases in 38 attempts during the month of July, 2nd-most in the New York-Penn League...Brooklyn stole just eight in June, but **Branden Fryman**, **Guillermo Granadillo** and **Ranfy Adon** have each stolen four bases during the month of August.

**REVOLVING DOOR:** INF / OF **Chandler Avant** was transferred to Brooklyn from Columbia (A) yesterday, while RHP **Josh Hejka** was received from Kingsport today.

**vs. CONNECTICUT:** The Cyclones are 31-26 against the Connecticut Tigers, the affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, since they arrived in the league in 2010...Brooklyn has split the 28 matchups at Dodd Stadium with Connecticut, owing a 17-12 record in Brooklyn...The Tigers used to be the Connecticut Defenders in the Double-A Eastern league as a San Francisco Giants affiliate 2003-2009.

**LUKE HITTER:** Brooklyn infielder **Luke Ritter** has hit safely in 15 of his last 19 games and has raised his batting average from .121 to .278 over this stretch... Ritter began his pro career 4-for-33 (.121) and is hitting .349 (23-64) since June 28th.

**FIRST PLACE:** Last night's victory pushed the Cyclones into first place in the McNamara Division, which is separated by fewer than three games from top to bottom...Brooklyn has been first or second in the league every day except for one this season when they slipped to fourth place with a 4-5 record.

**MOST RECENT REHABBER:** Irish-born LHP **P.J. Conlon** has made three rehab outings, throwing 3.1 innings of relief with two walks and four strikeouts... Conlon is down from Triple-A Syracuse to rehab a strained flexor in his throwing arm...He is the ninth player to rehab with Brooklyn this season and the fifth pitcher with MLB experience (Familia, Oswalt, Syndergaard, Wilson).

**DIRTY DOZEN:** INF **Yoel Romero** currently has a 12-game hitting streak, tied for the longest streak in the NYPL this season...Romero's streak is the 20th streak of 12 or more in franchise history and the longest since Walter Rasquin hit in 14 straight games during the 2017 season...The franchise record is 17 games by **Lucas Duda** from August 16, 2007 - September 2, 2007.

**STARTING TO FIND IT:** Has not allowed a run over his past 10 innings on the mound, tossing the longest scoreless streak for a Cyclones pitcher this season.

**HOMECOMING:** Grew up in nearby Windsor, north of Hartford about 45 minutes northwest of Dodd Stadium.

**2018 SEASON:** Pitched with Kingsport (R) last season, working as a starting pitcher...Went 1-4 with a 4.97 ERA over 10 starts, walking 40 batters and striking out just 26.

**WINDSOR TIES TO BROOKLYN:** Cleveland is the second professional player from Windsor, joining Dick Teed...Teed played 17 seasons in the pros, making one appearance in the Major Leagues...Teed pinch hit in one game for the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1953, striking out against the Milwaukee Braves on July 24...He was sent down, playing 10 more seasons in the minors without earning another call-up.

**FARM FAMILY:** Played for head coach Joe Serfass at Windsor High School...Serfass played in the Mets farm system from 2004-2007, reaching as high as Double-A Binghamton, but never played for the Cyclones.
