YESTERDAY: Brooklyn walked a season-high eight times in a 6-1 victory over the Connecticut Tigers in the series opener...RHP **Matt Cleveland** earned his second consecutive victory, while INF **Wilmer Reyes** slammed a two-run home run...RHP **Josh Hejka** made his Cyclones debut in relief.

WALK THIS WAY: Brooklyn reached base eight times via the walk Saturday night, setting a new season-high...Seven of the nine batters in the lineup record at least a walk or hit by pitch...INF **Nic Gaddis** reached base five times, walking three times...OF **Antoine Duplantis** reached four times on two hits, one walk, and a hit by pitch.

WELL, WE'RE WAITING: The Cyclones and Tigers played three hours and 45 minutes last night, shattering Brooklyn's previous high of three hours 11 minutes...Connecticut plays the longest games in the league, averaging three hours 21 minutes...Brooklyn averages two hours and 50 minutes, ranking seventh in the 14-team NYPL...Williamsports leads the league, playing two hours 43 minutes on average.

REYES ROLLING: INF Wilmer Reyes has 24 hits over his past 17 games since June 28, hitting .358 with hits in 14 of 17 contests...Since June 28, he's second in the league, slugging .567...He began the season 5-23 (.217) and now sits fifth in the NYPL with a .322 batting average.

WHO'S NOT: INF **Joe Genord** is currently 2-for-32 over his past 10 games with an at-bat... Over this span, he also has with 14 strikeouts...Genord's batting average has dropped from .297 to .235 over this stretch...Despite not homering in 16 straight games, he's still tied for fourth in the league with five home runs.

vs. CONNECTICUT: The Cyclones are 32-26 against the Connecticut Tigers, the affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, since they arrived in the league in 2010...Brooklyn has a 15-14 record at Dodd Stadium with Connecticut, owing a 17-12 record in Brooklyn...The Tigers used to be the Connecticut Defenders in the Double-A Eastern league as a San Francisco Giants affiliate 2003-2009.

SAVE ME: The Cyclones lead the league with 15 saves in 19 tries...When the team is ahead, Cyclones pitchers have a .214 opposing batting average -- good for third in the league and a 2.98 ERA and 1.19 WHIP that ranks fourth-best in the circuit.

RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT: Brooklyn ranks first in the New York-Penn League with a .280 (77-275) batting average with runners in scoring position and a .433 slugging percentage to lead the league.

SWIPING RIGHT: The Cyclones have stolen 32 bases in 39 attempts during the month of July, 2nd-most in the New York-Penn League...Brooklyn stole just eight in June, but **Branden Fryman**, **Guillermo Granadillo** and **Ranfy Adon** have each stolen four bases during the month of August.

LUKE HITTER: Brooklyn infielder **Luke Ritter** has hit safely in 15 of his last 19 games and has raised his batting average from .121 to .278 over this stretch...Ritter began his pro career 4-for-33 (.121) and is hitting .349 (23-64) since June 28th.

FIRST PLACE: Friday night's victory pushed the Cyclones into first place in the McNamara Division, which is separated by fewer than three games from top to bottom...Brooklyn has been first or second in the league every day except for one this season when they slipped to fourth place with a 4-5 record.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not allow a run Monday against West Virginia, striking out a career-high-tying seven batters over five innings of two-hit, two-walk ball...Went 5.0 innings for the fourth consecutive outing.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Bryant ranks eighth in the league with a .206 opponents batting average...The NYPL has success swinging at the first pitch, hitting 12-28 (.429) swinging at the first pitch and just 8-71 (.113) in any other count.

DO OVER: Spent 2018 in Kingsport for the second consecutive season...Went 1-3 with a 5.24 ERA in 11 games and eight starts last season, making drastic improvements in the Appalachian League when he was 0-5 with a 8.76 ERA in 12 games in 2017.

NEW MEXICO QB: Committed to play quarterback at New Mexico prior to conversations with the Mets.

I'LL TAKE A SHIRLEY TEMPLE: Bryant is just 20 years old, looking forward to his 21st birthday in December...Drafted in the 36th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Clearwater High School in Florida at 17 years old.

BOSTON STRONG: Born in New England, the Deerfield, New Hampshire native is a strong Boston sports fan...Loves the Patriots, Red Sox, and Bruins...Since he was born in December of 1998, Garrison has enjoyed 12 professional championships...Eli Manning and the New York Giants have also defeated the Patriots twice in the Super Bowl, leaving Bryant without two potential titles in his short lifetime.
