LAST NIGHT: 1B **Joe Genord** barreled a three-run home run in Brooklyn's four-run first inning en route to a 5-1 win in game two of a three-game set at Centennial Field...RHP Michel Otanez struck out five over five innings, allowing a home run to Vermont's **Logan Davidson**, Oakland's first round pick from Clemson.

TWO-OUT MAGIC: Brooklyn went 9-18 (.500) with two outs last night, including 7-10 over the first four innings.

ROAD SWEET ROAD: INF **Wilmer Reyes** is batting .340 (16-47) in 12 road games...INF **Yoel Romero** is batting .353 (18-51) in 13 games as a visitor...Overall Brooklyn is batting .245 on the road while Cyclones pitchers have limited the opposition to just a .193 average -- a league best.

WHO'S HOT: INF **Wilmer Reyes** is batting .329 (25-76) with 13 RBIs during the month of July...INF **Yoel Romero** (.421 in 10 games), INF **Branden Fryman** (.349 in 12 games) and OF **Ranfy Adon** (.302 in 12 games) are the only other players batting over .300 for the month...Adon and Fryman have not played since July 18th due to injury.

RETURN TO ME: 1B **Joe Genord** is 4-for-11 over his past three games with a double, home run and four RBIs...Genord is trying to reverse a 3-for-41 (.073) over his 15 games from July 8-July 24...Genord is tied for third in homers (6), fifth in RBIs (25), and tied for sixth in extra-base hits (14).

RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT: Brooklyn ranks first in the New York-Penn League with a .277 (91-328) batting average and a .421 slugging percentage with runners in scoring position...Brooklyn is batting .291 with RISP and two-outs, best in the league...West Virginia ranks second (.285).

vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones head to Centennial Field in Burlington...Brooklyn is 68-33 all-time against the Oakland affiliate, playing the 101st contest last night on the road where the team is 35-18...The Cyclones have also dominated at MCU Park, winning 33 of the 48 meetings...Centennial Field is the oldest in professional baseball founded in 1906, older than Wrigley and Fenway Park.

SERIES SMILES: The Cyclones have won five of their past six series, going 5-0-1...Brooklyn beat Mahoning Valley, West Virginia, Hudson Valley, Tri-City, and now Vermont with last night's victory...Brooklyn's only tie game in Connecticut, when the Cyclones and Tigers were rained out before the rubber game earlier this week.

SWIPING RIGHT: The Cyclones have stolen 41 bases in 53 attempts during the month of July, ranking second-most in the New York-Penn League...Brooklyn stole just eight in June...INF **Wilmer Reyes** and **Jake Mangum** have stolen six bases each during the month.

DIRTY DOZEN: INF **Yoel Romero** currently has a 14-game hitting streak, the longest streak in the NYPL this season...Romero's streak is the 20th streak of 12 or more in franchise history and the longest since Walter Rasquin hit in 14 straight games in 2017...The franchise record is 17 games by **Lucas Duda** from August 16, 2007 - September 2, 2007.

HOMECOMING: Brooklyn returns home Tuesday through Thursday to play a four-game series against the Lowell Spinners, the first-place team in the Stedler Division.
