**YESTERDAY:** Brooklyn suffered a doubleheader sweep at the hands of the Lowell Spinners, losing 6-2 and 4-3...Brooklyn held a 3-2 lead in the second game, but RHP **Matt Mullenbach** blew the save and took the loss...INF **Wilmer Reyes** went a combined 3-6 over the two games and OF **Jake Mangum** collected two hits and two RBIs.

**ROMERO RAKED:** INF **Yoel Romero** snapped his 15-game hitting streak yesterday, the longest in the NYPL this season...Romero had not gone hitless in a game since June 25th...Romero batted .397 (23-58) over his 15-game streak...The 15-game hitting streak is tied for the third-longest in franchise history - 1B **Ike Davis** and INF **Joe Jiannetti** also hit in 15 straight games...1B **Lucas Duda** (17 games, 2007) and INF **Gavin Cecchini** (16 games, 2013) are the only players with longer streaks.

**LOWELL SPINNING:** The Spinners have several batters hitting well against Brooklyn through seven games...OF **Gilberto Jimenez** leads the way going 8-21 (.381), while OF **Marino Campana** is 5-11 with a home run and three steals...Spinners C **Jaxx Groshans** has hit both of his pro homers against Brooklyn this season.

**RISP IT FOR THE BISCUIT:** Brooklyn ranks first in the New York-Penn League with a .281 (99-352) batting average and a .432 slugging percentage with runners in scoring position...Brooklyn is batting .293 with RISP and two outs, best in the league...West Virginia ranks second (.278).

**SERIES SMILES:** The Cyclones have won five of their past six series, going 5-0-1...Brooklyn beat Mahoning Valley, West Virginia, Hudson Valley, Tri-City, and now Vermont with last weekend's sweep...Brooklyn's only tie came in Connecticut, when the Cyclones and Tigers were rained out for the rubber game two weekends ago.

**vs. LOWELL:** The Cyclones are 59-47 all-time against the Lowell Spinners, including 34-24 at MCU Park and 25-23 at LeLacheur Park...The Cyclones are 10-5 against the Spinners at home over the last three seasons...Brooklyn took two of three from Lowell at MCU Park earlier this season and split a pair in Lowell.

**SWIPING RIGHT:** The Cyclones have stolen 42 bases in 56 attempts during the month of July, ranking second-most in the New York-Penn League...Brooklyn stole just eight in June...INF **Wilmer Reyes** and **Jake Mangum** have stolen six bases each during the month.

**LEADERS OF THE PACK:** INF **Wilmer Reyes** ranks fifth in the league in batting (.345), hits (41), and fifth in slugging (.513)...1B **Joe Genord** is tied for third in home runs (6) and is fifth in RBI (25)...2B **Luke Ritter** is fifth in the league with 21 walks.

**WELCOME BACK:** C **Jake Ortega**, the Mets' 28th round pick out Cal State-Bakersfield, returns to the team today after playing five games with St. Lucie in the Florida State League...Ortega tallied four hits in five games and threw out four of eight basestealers.

**IRISH NIGHT:** Brooklyn transforms itself Thursday vs. Lowell at 7 p.m. for Irish Night presented by Budweiser...The first 2,000 fans will receive a Celtic Knot Jersey.

**LITTLE LEAGUE BOUND:** Brooklyn heads to Williamsport, Pennsylvania for the weekend, playing the CrossCutters, the affiliate of the Phillies, Friday through Sunday...Brooklyn faces the Philadelphia affiliate on the road for the first time since 2016.

**2018 SEASON:** Pitched with Kingsport (R) last season, working as a starting pitcher...Went 1-4 with a 4.97 ERA over 10 starts, walking 40 batters and striking out just 26.

**WINDSOR TIES TO BROOKLYN:** Cleveland is the second professional player from Windsor, joining Dick Teed...Teed played 17 seasons in the pros, making one appearance in the Major Leagues...Teed pinch hit in one game for the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1953, striking out against the Milwaukee Braves on July 24...He was sent down, playing 10 more seasons in the minors without earning another call-up.

**FARM FAMILY:** Played for head coach Joe Serfass at Windsor High School...Serfass played in the Mets farm system from 2004-2007, reaching as high as Double-A Binghamton, but never played for the Cyclones.
