**LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones rallied from a 4-0 deficit to score eight runs in the last three innings and run away with an 8-5 win over Hudson Valley...Trailing 4-2 in the eighth, INF **Yoel Romero** connected on a two-run home run to tie the game...Hudson Valley would retake the lead in the bottom of the frame, but an RBI single from **Sam Haggerty** in the ninth knotted things back up before **Joe Genord** hit a three-run blast to give Brooklyn the 8-5 win.

**SINCE WE LAST MET:** RHP **Daison Acosta** was transferred to Columbia (A) of the South Atlantic League...RHP **Cole Gordon** and OF **Zach Rheams** were also promoted to Columbia...INF **Angel Manzanarez** was transferred to Kingsport (Appalachian League)...OF **Jose Medina** was transferred to St. Lucie (A+) of the Florida State League...Brooklyn also received RHP **Alec Kisena** from Columbia.

**NAIL-BITING:** The Cyclones have played 10 one-run games, going 8-2 in those contests...The Cyclones have been outscored by 9 runs this season...In wins, Brooklyn is +17 in run differential, but -26 in losses.

**JOEY BIG TIME:** INF **Joe Genord** currently ranks sixth in the NYPL in batting (.339), leads the league in HR (5), is tied for the league lead in RBI (15), and leads the league in slugging percentage (.696) and OPS (1.087)...Genord leads all Brooklyn qualified hitters in 10 different batting statistics.

**POWER SURGE:** Over the last seven days, Brooklyn leads the New York-Penn League with a .280 (71-254) team batting average...They have also scored more runs (38), have more total bases (106), and have hit more home runs (7) than any other team in the league.

**vs. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones are 102-74 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 48-42 at MCU Park...Brooklyn has started the season 4-1 against Aberdeen, including a three-game road sweep at the IronBirds last week...The Cyclones won all three games by one run, including two that ended in extra innings...Brooklyn hasn't won the season series against Aberdeen since 2016.

**ALL IN THE HITS:** Brooklyn started the 2019 season by hitting .173 (48-278) through their first nine games...Since then, the team is batting .273 (88-322) and has climbed from last in the NYPL in batting to sixth in the NYPL.

**INDEPENDENCE DAY:** Brooklyn is 11-7 all-time on the 4th of July...Today marks only the seventh time in franchise history that the Cyclones have played at home on July 4th: 2003, 2004, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2017.

**FRANKLY SPEAKING:** Today, the Cyclones will transform into the Coney Island Franks...The team first unveiled their alter egos in 2016 to celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Nathan's Famous...The game-worn jerseys from today will be available for auction through the Live Source App.

**ONE, TWO PUNCH:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have recently added OF **Jake Mangum** and OF **Antoine Duplantis** to the roster...Mangum, who starred at Mississippi State, and Duplantis, who played for LSU, rank 1st and 2nd all-time in hits in the SEC.

**DON'T CROSS THE STREAMS:** The Cyclones will be the first - and only - team in Minor League Baseball who will stream games through Facebook Live this season...Brooklyn will stream all 38 home games exclusively through Facebook Live as part of a partnership with Sling Studio...All other MiLB teams that offer streaming must use MiLB TV.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his first Brooklyn start Sunday against Staten Island after piggybacking with Nathan Jones his first time, lasting just 3 1/3 innings in the loss...Struck out six and walked one.

**DO OVER:** Spent 2018 in Kingsport for the second consecutive season...Went 1-3 with a 5.24 ERA in 11 games and eight starts last season, making drastic improvements in the Appalachian League when he was 0-5 with a 8.76 ERA in 12 games in 2017.

**BURSTS OF BRYANT:** Despite a minor league career ERA of 7.07, the righty has compiled six six-plus strikeout performances in the past year-plus...Since 2018 began, Bryant has a strikeout rate of 26%.

**I'LL TAKE A SHIRLEY TEMPLE:** Bryant is just 20 years old, looking forward to his 21st birthday in December...Drafted in the 36th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Clearwater High School in Florida at 17 years old...Along with Daison Acosta, Bryant is the youngest starting pitcher on the roster.

**BOSTON STRONG:** Born in New England, the Deerfield, New Hampshire native is a strong Boston sports fan...Loves the Patriots, Red Sox, and Bruins...Since he was born in December of 1998, Garrison has enjoyed 12 professional championships...Eli Manning and the New York Giants have also defeated the Patriots twice in the Super Bowl, leaving Bryant without two potential titles in his short lifetime.
