YESTERDAY: Down 2-0 in the sixth, the Cyclones rallied for four runs, including **Anthony Dirocie's** two-run single to give Brooklyn the lead for good... **Dan Goggin** and **Matt Mullenbach** combined to throw five hitless, scoreless frames to earn the win and the save respectively...INF **Yoel Romero** extended his hitting streak to 10 games.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Brooklyn heads upstate to face the Tri-City ValleyCats for the 12th away game of the season...The Cyclones are 8-3 on the road this season and just 4-7 at home, winning series at Hudson Valley (2-1) and Aberdeen (3-0) and splitting two games at Lowell...Brooklyn has not had a winning record on the road since 2012 when the team finished 24-14 en route to a 45-31 record and an NYPL Wild Card appearance.

JOEY BATS: 1B **Joe Genord** currently ranks seventh in the NYPL in batting (.314) leads the league in HR (5) and RBI (18), and leads the league in slugging (.614) and OPS (.989)...Leads all Brooklyn qualified hitters in 10 different batting statistics...Has driven in 11 runs and has five extra-base hits over his last six games.

RED-HOT ROMERO: INF **Yoel Romero** has compiled a team-best 10-game hitting streak, going 14-for-38 (.368) with a double, two home runs, seven RBI, and six runs over this stretch...Romero ranks second on the team with 20 hits...His longest career hitting streak lasted 21 straight games, beginning in August '17 and carrying into the '18 season.

HANG TEN: INF **Yoel Romero** currently has a 10-game hitting streak, tied for the fourth longest streak in the NYPL this season, and is the second longest streak that took place exclusively in 2019...Romero's streak is the 41st streak of 10 or more game in franchise history...INF **Lucas Duda** holds the franchise record with a 17-game streak.

vs. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 50-47 all-time against Tri-City, but have gone 19-35 since 2011 after going 20-12 against the 'Cats from 2002-10... Brooklyn has not won a season series against Tri-City since 2010...The Cyclones went 1-2 at home and 2-4 at "The Joe" in 2018...Brooklyn owns a 25-20 record at MCU Park against the 'Cats and a 25-27 mark on the road in Troy.

NAIL-BITING: The Cyclones have played 11 one-run games, going 8-3 in those contests...The Cyclones have been outscored by 13 runs this season...In wins, Brooklyn is +21 in run differential, but -34 in losses.

AGGRESSIVE BY NATURE: Brooklyn ranks last in the league in walks, taking 56 over the first 21 games for a league-lowest .283 on-base percentage...**Luke Ritter** leads the team with 11 free passes which is five more than the next closest teammate, but ranks tied for seventh in the league.

A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have thrown 32 wild pitches this season, most in the New York-Penn League...That includes 22 wild pitches with runners in scoring position, also tops in the league...By comparison 14 teams in the Major Leagues have thrown less than 32 wild pitches as MLB enters the All-Star Break.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER: The Cyclones have not had a lead prior to the fifth inning during any game during the month of July...Brooklyn has been outscored 21-4 over the first four innings of games in July, but has outscored opponents 26-9 from the fifth inning on.

ROSTER MOVE: RHP **Yeudy Colon** was transferred to Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League...RHP **Jared Biddy** will join Brooklyn from the K-Mets after three scoreless appearances in the Appy League.

LAST TIME OUT: Lasted a season-long 5.1 innings at Hudson Valley in his third-consecutive no-decision...Struck out a season-high tying three but walked a season-high four.

2018 SEASON: Pitched with Kingsport (R) last season, working as a starting pitcher...Went 1-4 with a 4.97 ERA over 10 starts, walking 40 batters and striking out just 26.

SEASON FOUR: The tall right-hander pitched in the GCL for his first two seasons before making the jump to the Appalachian League with Kingsport last season.

WALKS GON' KILL YA: Cleveland has struggled with walks throughout his career...Has walked 70 in 91.1 innings, while striking out just 52 for a walk rate of 17 percent...Walked at least five batters in four of 10 starts last year with the K-Mets.

WINDSOR TIES TO BROOKLYN: Cleveland is the second professional player from Windsor, joining Dick Teed...Teed played 17 seasons in the pros, making one appearance in the Major Leagues...Teed pinch hit in one game for the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1953, striking out against the Milwaukee Braves on July 24...He was sent down, playing 10 more seasons in the minors without earning another call-up.

FARM FAMILY: Played for head coach Joe Serfass at Windsor High School...Serfass played in the Mets farm system from 2004-2007, reaching as high as Double-A Binghamton, but never played for the Cyclones.
