ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn banged home four runs in the bottom of the sixth, breaking a 1-1 tie en route to a 5-4 victory against Staten Island. **Joe Genord** homered and **Nic Gaddis** doubled twice, driving in one. **Brian Metoyer** tossed 1.2 scoreless innings for the save.

WHO IS THAT GUY?: New York Mets left-handed reliever **Justin Wilson** is scheduled to pitch one inning Saturday at Staten Island with scheduled starter RHP **Jaison Vilera** to follow...The eight-year MLB veteran is on the 10-day injured list with left elbow soreness...Wilson pitched twice with Triple-A Syracuse, tossing one inning each time...The 31 year old southpaw was signed by the Mets in the offseason, and has played for five MLB teams.

HAPPY DAYS IN BROOKLYN: Fonzie returns to the Cyclones for his third season as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones, and fifth season as a member of the coaching staff...Fonzie is 65-87 in his three years as manager...He will be joined by an entirely new coaching staff this season including former Mets OF **Endy Chavez**, pitching coach **Josué Matos**, and hitting coach **Delwyn Young**.

HEY, I KNOW THOSE GUYS: There are six players on the Cyclones Opening Day roster who have played for the Cyclones previously, including three players who have been New York-Penn League All-Stars...RHP **Yeudy Colon** and RHP **Jaison Vilera** were both All-Stars in 2018 and OF **Jose Medina** was an All-Star in 2017...In addition, OF **Guillermo Granadillo** (2017), OF **Anthony Dirocie** (2018) and INF **Angel Manzanarez** (2018) have previously played for Brooklyn.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: There are 11 players from the recent MLB Draft that will be in uniform for the Cyclones this evening...The four position players INF **Nic Gaddis**, INF **Joe Genord**, INF **Luke**

vs. STATEN ISLAND : The Cyclones are 117-113 against the Staten Island Yankees...Brooklyn has more wins against Staten Island than any other franchise in the New York-Penn League...The Cyclones are 63-54 all-time at MCU Park and 54-59 at Staten Island...Brooklyn and Staten Island tied the season series in 2018, 6-6...Brooklyn hasn't won a season series from the Yankees since 2014.

Ritter and OF **Zach Ashford** are all expected to make their professional debuts on Friday night...The other players, all pitchers, will be with the team but not on the active roster until they complete their throwing programs.

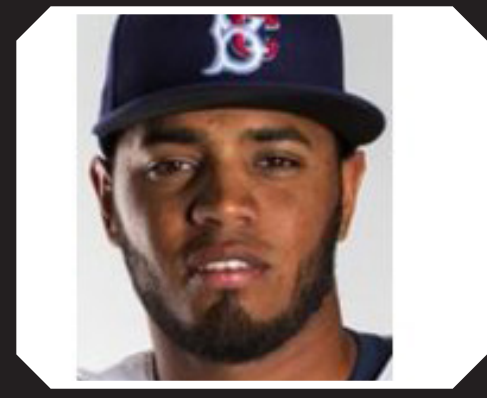
EARLY RISER: RHP **Ryley Gilliam**, who spent the 2018 season with the Cyclones appearing in 17 games, has already climbed the ladder to Syracuse (AAA)...The righthander who was selected in the 5th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Clemson University made his AAA debut on June 11th.

DON'T CROSS THE STREAMS: The Cyclones will be the first - and only - team in Minor League Baseball who will stream games through Facebook Live this season...Brooklyn will stream all 38 home games exclusively through Facebook Live as part of a partnership with Sling Studio...All other MiLB teams that offer streaming use MiLB TV.

FROM BROOKLYN TO QUEENS: There have been four players who have been in the Opening Day lineup for the Brooklyn Cyclones and the New York Mets, including two this year...**Mike Jacobs** was the Opening Day catcher for the Cyclones in the first game in franchise history in 2001, and then the Mets Opening Day first baseman in 2010...**Lucas Duda** was the DH for the Cyclones in 2007 and was in the Mets Opening Day lineup four times...**Amed Rosario** (2014) and **Brandon Nimmo** (2012) have been in the Mets Opening Day lineup the last two years.

NYPL STUD: Jaison Vilera turned in an immaculate 2018 campaign with the Cyclones, earning NYPL All-Star nods and *Baseball America* Short-Season All-Star awards with a league-leading 1.83 earned run average...Vilera fanned 78 in 73.2 innings, allowing three earned runs or fewer in 12 of 13 starts.

COLUMBIA STUMBLES: After a terrific 2018, Vilera broke 2019 Spring Training camp with the full-season Columbia Fireflies (A)...Made four appearances, posting a 1-2 record and 8.44 ERA...Inconsistency led to his demotion...outings one and three, he allowed two earned runs over 11 innings...outings two and four, he yielded 15 runs in five innings.

STILL GOT IT: Despite the demotion and early exit from the Columbia roster in late April, Vilera made a spot appearance for Advanced-A St. Lucie on June 8, tossing four innings of one-run ball.

MICROSCOPIC ERA: With 212.2 innings pitched and counting, Vilera's 2.29 career ERA continues to be impressive...Has allowed four runs or fewer in 39 of 42 professional appearances (93%).

GREAT IN THE GCL: Posted a 1.88 ERA with the GCL Mets in 2017, his first professional season on American soil...Named a Post-Season All-Star in the Gulf Coast League.

CARACAS KID: Hails from the capital and largest city in Venezuela...a city of more the 1.9 million people.
