ABOUT YESTERDAY: Four Cyclones pitchers combined on a two-hitter as Brooklyn defeated Aberdeen 4-1 on Monday night at MCU Park...RHP **Garrison Bryant** (1-0) struck out seven over his 4.2 innings to collect the win...2B **Luke Ritter** connected on his first professional home run, a two-run shot in the third to extend Brooklyn's lead to 4-0... Both of Aberdeen's hits were infield singles.

HAPPY DAYS IN BROOKLYN: Fonzie returns to the Cyclones for his third season as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones, and fifth season as a member of the coaching staff...Fonzie is 68-88 in his three plus seasons as manager...He will be joined by an entirely new coaching staff this season including former Mets OF **Endy Chavez**, pitching coach **Josué Matos**, and hitting coach **Delwyn Young**.

HEY, I KNOW THOSE GUYS: There are six players on the Cyclones Opening Day roster who have played for the Cyclones previously, including three players who have been New York-Penn League All-Stars...RHP **Yeudy Colon** and RHP **Jaison Vilera** were both All-Stars in 2018 and OF **Jose Medina** was an All-Star in 2017...In addition, OF **Guillermo Granadillo** (2017), OF **Anthony Dirocie** (2018) and INF **Angel Manzanarez** (2018) have previously played for Brooklyn.

A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: Cyclones pitchers have thrown a league leading 10 wild pitches through the first four games of the season...They have also walked 17 batters third most in the NYPL behind Aberdeen (21) and Connecticut (21).

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Brooklyn is off to a 3-1 start despite batting just .185 (22-119) as a team... The Cyclones are one of six teams in the league batting under .200...Ten of Brooklyn's 22 hits have gone for extra bases - eight doubles and two home runs.

vs. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 56-43 all-time against the Lowell Spinners including 24-22 in Lowell...The Cyclones are just 2-8 in Lowell since 2015...The Cyclones won their only game at LeLacheur Park last season...The second game of a doubleheader was cancelled and was not made up...The Cyclones ended up missing out on the playoffs by 1/2 game.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: There are 11 players from the recent MLB Draft that will be in uniform for the Cyclones this evening...The four position players INF **Nic Gaddis**, INF **Joe Genord**, INF **Luke Ritter** and OF **Zach Ashford** all made their pro debuts on Friday...RHP **Justin Lasko** and LHP **Andrew Edwards**, RHP **Mitch Ragan**, and RHP **Dan Goggin** have all made their respective debuts.

RISP & REWARD: The Cyclones are currently third in the New York-Penn League with a .273 (6-22) batting average with runners in scoring position...The 22-at-bats with runners in scoring position are third fewest in the NYPL behind Tri-City (17) and Staten Island (21).

COPA DE LA DIVERSION: When Brooklyn returns to MCU Park it will be a Friday Fiesta as they transform into the Brooklyn Jefes for the first of three games this season as part of MiLB's Copa...The first 2,000 fans in attendance will receive a Roberto Clemente Bobblehead and the Clemente Family will be in attendance as we pay homage to "The Great One."

FEELING A DRAFT: Through four games, both of the Cyclones home runs have been struck by 2019 Draft Picks (1B **Joe Genord** / 2B **Luke Ritter**)...Recently drafted pitching, have tossed 5.1 shutout innings on the mound as well.
