ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The series finale between the Cyclones and Spinners was rained out in Lowell, MA last night...The game will be made up in Brooklyn as part of a single-admission doubleheader on Saturday, June 29th when the Spinners come to MCU Park...Both games will be seven innings, as is the norm in MiLB, and the first game will begin at 5:00 PM.

COPA DE LA DIVERSION: Tonight marks the first of three Friday Night Fiestas as part of MiLB's Copa de la Diversión...This year, 72 teams across Minor League Baseball will participate in the "Fun Cup," a season-long competition aimed at engaging, embracing and honoring Hispanic and Latino communities across the baseball landscape...The Cyclones will take the field as the Brooklyn Jefes for their three Copa games: tonight, July 12 and August 9th...Brooklyn went 3-0 as the Jefes in '18.

ROBERTO CLEMENTE: The first 2,000 fans in attendance at Friday night's game will receive a Roberto Clemente Puerto Rico Bobblehead...In addition, the Cyclones partnered with the Clemente Foundation to unveil a portrait of Roberto Clemente at P.S. 13 - The Roberto Clemente School...Luis Clemente, Roberto's son, will be in attendance at this evening's game and will accept a donation from the Cyclones on behalf of the Roberto Clemente Foundation.

A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: Cyclones pitchers have thrown a league leading 13 wild pitches through the first six games of the season.

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Brooklyn is off to a 4-2 start despite batting just .185 (34-184) as a team, second lowest in the league ahead of Staten Island (.151)...Fourteen of Brooklyn's 34 hits (41%) have gone for extra-bases.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 118-113 against the Staten Island Yankees all-time...The 118 wins are the most wins the Cyclones have against any opponent...Brooklyn is 2-0 against the Yankees this year including 1-0 at MCU Park...The Cyclones are 63-54 all-time here on Coney Island and 55-59 all-time at Richmond County Bank Ballpark at St. George.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP **Corey Oswalt**, a 2014 New York-Penn League All-Star, has joined the Cyclones as part of a MiLB Rehab assignment from Syracuse (AAA)...He made his first outing on Wednesday night, tossing 1.1 innings and allowing one run on three hits...In addition, C **Jake Ortega** has been added to the Cyclones roster from the 2019 MLB Draft...He was a 28th round selection from Cal State-Bakersfield...During his senior season he led the team with a .326 average and a .418 OBP.

FEELING BULL-ISH: Cyclones relievers have allowed just six earned runs in 29.0 innings pitched for a 1.86 ERA.

J-ACE-ON: Tonight's starter, RHP **Jaison Vilera** led the New York-Penn League with a 1.83 ERA and 78 strikeouts during the 2018 season...He was named the New York-Penn League All-Star team.

DON'T CROSS THE STREAMS: The Cyclones will be the first - and only - team in Minor League Baseball who will stream games through Facebook Live this season...Brooklyn will stream all 38 home games exclusively through Facebook Live as part of a partnership with Sling Studio...All other MiLB teams that offer streaming, must use MiLB TV.

SUNDAY: The Cyclones will close out their three-game series with the Yankees on Sunday with Jewish Heritage Night...The first 2,000 fans in attendance will receive a Mensch on a Bench Bobble.

LAST TIME OUT: Vilera returned to NYPL form, earning the win Saturday at Staten Island with 6 2/3 innings of one-run ball...Exited in the 7th inning and was charged his only earned run when reliever Nelson Leon threw a wild pitch.

NYPL STUD: Jaison Vilera turned in an immaculate 2018 campaign with the Cyclones, earning NYPL All-Star nods and *Baseball America* Short-Season All-Star awards with a league-leading 1.83 earned run average...Vilera fanned 78 in 73.2 innings, allowing three earned runs or fewer in 12 of 13 starts.

COLUMBIA STUMBLES: After a terrific 2018, Vilera broke 2019 Spring Training camp with the full-season Columbia Fireflies (A)...Made four appearances, posting a 1-2 record and 8.44 ERA...Inconsistency led to his demotion...outings one and three, he allowed two earned runs over 11 innings...outings two and four, he yielded 15 runs in five innings.

MICROSCOPIC ERA: With 219.1 innings pitched and counting, Vilera's 2.26 career ERA continues to be impressive...Has allowed four runs or fewer in 40 of 43 professional appearances (93%).

GREAT IN THE GCL: Posted a 1.88 ERA with the GCL Mets in 2017, his first professional season on American soil...Named a Post-Season All-Star in the Gulf Coast League.

CARACAS KID: Hails from the capital and largest city in Venezuela...a city of more the 1.9 million people.
