ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn took the field as “Los Jefes” for the first time in 2019, but fell to the Staten Island Yankees 10-3 in the series opener...SS **Yoel Romero** collected an extra-base hit in his third straight game, going 2-4 with two doubles and a RBI...1B **Joe Genord** had his second straight multi-hit game, going 2-4 with a double and a run scored...RHP **Jaison Vilera** struggled for the first time in a Brooklyn uniform, allowing five runs on eight hits in four innings...After going 3-0 last year, the loss was Brooklyn’s first while playing as the Jefes.

A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: Cyclones pitchers have thrown 15 wild pitches through the first seven games of the season, tied for second-most in the NYPL behind Aberdeen’s 16...Tonight’s starting pitcher, RHP **Matt Cleveland**, threw three wild pitches in four innings Sunday against Aberdeen.

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Brooklyn is off to a 4-3 start despite batting just .186 (41-220) as a team, second-lowest in the league ahead of Staten Island (.173)...19 of Brooklyn’s 41 hits (47%) have gone for extra bases.

FEELING BULL-ISH: Cyclones relievers have posted a 2.91 ERA and stranded 13 of 15 inherited runners (87%)...The bullpen is a perfect 4-for-4 in save opportunities, second-most in the league...RHP **Andrew Edwards** is tied for second in the NYPL with two saves...However, the bullpen has allowed eight runs in the last two games, including five runs last night.

STARTING STRONG: INF **Wilmer Reyes** and C **Jose Mena** have collected hits in all of their first few games as Cyclones...Reyes has started his Brooklyn career on a four-game hitting streak, picking up a double and a RBI yesterday...Mena has hits in his first three Brooklyn ballgames, including a double and a run scored last night.

vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 118-114 against the Staten Island Yankees all-time...The 118 wins are the most wins the Cyclones have against any opponent...Brooklyn is 2-1 against the Yankees this year, including 1-0 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark...The Cyclones are 63-55 all-time on Coney Island and 55-59 all-time at Richmond County Bank Ballpark at St. George.

IT’S ALL IN THE RISP: Brooklyn bats struggled with runners in scoring position last night, going 2-16 in those situations with six runners left on base - all in scoring position...Through the first seven games, Brooklyn is batting .271 (13-48) with RISP.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP **Corey Oswalt**, a 2014 New York-Penn League All-Star, has joined the Cyclones as part of a MiLB Rehab assignment from Syracuse (AAA)...He made his first outing on Wednesday night, tossing 1.1 innings and allowing one run on three hits...In addition, C **Jake Ortega** was added to the Cyclones roster yesterday from the 2019 MLB Draft...Ortega pinch-hit in the ninth inning last night, flying out to right field...He was a 28th-round selection from Cal State-Bakersfield, leading the team with a .326 average and a .418 OBP this spring.

DON’T CROSS THE STREAMS: The Cyclones will be the first - and only - team in Minor League Baseball who will stream games through Facebook Live this season...Brooklyn will stream all 38 home games exclusively through Facebook Live as part of a partnership with Sling Studio...All other MiLB teams that offer streaming must use MiLB TV.

SUNDAY: The Cyclones will close out their three-game series with the Staten Island Yankees tomorrow at 4 p.m. with Jewish Heritage Night...The first 2,000 fans in attendance will receive a Mensch on a Bench Bobblehead.

LAST TIME OUT: Struggled in his first start above Rookie ball, allowing three runs on five hits over four innings of work...Did not record a strike out, his first time failing to do so in 15 career starts...Walked three batters and threw three wild pitches.

2018 SEASON: Pitched with Kingsport (R) last season, working as a starting pitcher...Went 1-4 with a 4.97 ERA over 10 starts, walking 40 batters and striking out just 26.

SEASON FOUR: The tall right-hander pitched in the GCL for his first two seasons before making the jump to the Appalachian League with Kingsport last season.

WALKS GON' KILL YA: Cleveland has struggled with walks throughout his career...Has walked 58 in 73.2 innings, while striking out just 45 for a walk rate of 17 percent...Walked at least five batters in four of 10 starts last year with the K-Mets.

WINDSOR TIES TO BROOKLYN: Cleveland is the second professional player from Windsor, joining Dick Teed...Teed played 17 seasons in the pros, making one appearance in the Major Leagues...Teed pinch hit in one game for the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1953, striking out against the Milwaukee Braves on July 24...He was sent down, playing 10 more seasons in the minors without earning another call-up.

FARM FAMILY: Played for head coach Joe Serfass at Windsor High School...Serfass played in the Mets farm system from 2004-2007, reaching as high as Double-A Binghamton, but never played for the Cyclones.
