LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones held off a ninth inning rally from the IronBirds to win 7-6 on Tuesday night at Ripken Stadium...RHP **Noah Syndergaard** (1-0) made the rehab start for Brooklyn and struck out nine batters over his 5.0 innings on the mound...1B **Joe Genord** went 3-for-4 and OF **Ranfy Adon** added a 3-for-4 effort with a home run and three RBIs to pace the Brooklyn bats.

100 WINNING WAYS: Last night was Brooklyn's 100th win over the IronBirds in franchise history...Aberdeen is the second team that has lost 100 games to Brooklyn, joining Staten Island.

GAVIN GETS BACK: Syracuse Mets rehabber **Gavin Cecchini** continues his stint with the Cyclones, having played Sunday against Staten Island and last night in Aberdeen...Cecchini is rehabbing a quad injury and has yet to play a game this season with Syracuse...Cecchini played with the Cyclones for five games in 2012 and for the full season in 2013, hitting .273 in 51 games.

MORE REHABBERS!: RHP **Corey Oswalt**, a 2014 New York-Penn League All-Star, has joined the Cyclones as part of a MiLB Rehab assignment from Syracuse (AAA)...He made his first outing on Wednesday night at Lowell, tossing 1.1 innings and allowing one run on three hits.

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Brooklyn is batting just .187 (59-315) as a team, falling to last in the league 12 points below the next-closest team, the Auburn Doubledays (.199)...The Cyclones have also scored just 31 runs, second fewest in the league behind Williamsport (30).

A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: Cyclones pitchers have thrown 19 wild pitches through the first 10 games of the season, tied for second most in the NYPL with Aberdeen and behind Mah. Valley (21).

vs. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 100-74 all-time against the Aberdeen IronBirds, including 48-42 at MCU Park...The Cyclones went 4-5 against the 'Birds in 2018 and have won the season series just once (2016, 8-4) in the past four years...Brooklyn is just 4-10 against Aberdeen at home over the past three years...Brooklyn is 52-32 all-time at Ripken Stadium in Maryland.

WE HARDLY KNEW YE: RHP **Jaison Vilera** has been transferred to Binghamton (AA) of the Eastern League...RHP **Yeizo Campos** was transferred to St. Lucie (A+) of the Florida State League.

DOCTOR'S NOTE: RHP **Nate Jones** (illness) is not currently available to play...C **Phil Capra** (hand) and RHP **Malky Mena** (elbow) are also not currently available.

JAKE AND THE BAT MAN: The New York Mets announced that they have signed 4th round selection OF **Jake Mangum** from Mississippi State...He is expected to join the Cyclones in the next week...Mangum is the all-time hits leader in SEC history, and set the Mississippi State single season record for hits this year with 108.

DON'T CROSS THE STREAMS: The Cyclones will be the first - and only - team in Minor League Baseball who will stream games through Facebook Live this season...Brooklyn will stream all 38 home games exclusively through Facebook Live as part of a partnership with Sling Studio...All other MiLB teams that offer streaming must use MiLB TV.

FRIDAY: The Cyclones will return home to face the Lowell Spinners for a four-game set, including a Saturday doubleheader beginning at 5 p.m...Friday night Brooklyn will give out a Noah Syndergaard #PitchersWhoRake batter bobblehead to the first 2,000 fans through the gates.

TODAY: Corey Oswalt makes his second rehab start for the Brooklyn Cyclones this season, coming down from the Triple-A Syracuse roster...Oswalt spent the 2014 season with the Cyclones.

REHAB ROUND 2: Oswalt tossed 1 1/3 innings at Lowell last Wednesday, allowing three hits, one hit batsman, and one walk in a no-decision.

BACK IN BKLYN: Oswalt's third professional season brought him to Coney Island as a 20 year old...Posted the lowest season ERA of his career at 2.26, throwing 67.2 IP en route to a mid-season NYPL All-Star nod, a NYPL Pitcher of the Week award, and *Baseball America* Short-Season All-Star awards.

BIG LEAGUE COREY: Made his Major League debut with the Mets on April 21, 2018 at St. Louis...Did not get a decision in New York's 9-1 loss at Busch Stadium...Struck out four over 4.2 innings of two-run, two-hit ball...Gave up a two-run home run to Jedd Gyorko in his final inning of work...Over the past two seasons, Oswalt has made 12 starts and seven relief appearances covering 71.1 innings in the bigs.

A PRESIDENTIAL PICK: Selected by the Mets in the 7th round out of James Madison High School in San Diego... Notable attendees include Mark Hamill, who played Luke Skywalker in Star Wars, and Bob Taylor who is the founder of the famous Taylor line of guitars.
