LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones fell to the Staten Island Yankees by the score of 3-2 in front of a crowd of 9,000 in the home opener of the 2011 schedule...Recent draft picks **Danny Munro** and **Travis Taijeron** continued their hot starts, each collecting a pair of hits...Munro has reached base in six of his nine plate appearances...The Cyclones rallied in the ninth scoring a run and getting the tying run on base, but failed to get him around to score.

HOME OPENER: The Cyclones are now 9-2 all-time in their first home game of the season... Both of their losses in the home opener have come against the Staten Island Yankees, last night and in 2006.

CYCLONES vs. YANKEES: The Cyclones enter tonight's game with a 65-63 record against the Staten Island Yankees since the team's inception in 2001...Last season the Cyclones finished 16.5 games ahead of the Yankees in the standings, but the two teams split the season series, 7-7...The two teams split the series in 2009 and 2007 as well, with the Cyclones taking the season series last in 2008 and the Yankees in 2006.

AT THE GAME TONIGHT: TNA Wrestling star Eric Young will throw out the ceremonial first pitch and sign autographs on the concourse...TNA will return to MCU Park on July 3rd for BaseBrawl featuring...Also, before the game fans are allowed to participate in a pre-game catch on the field and post-game kids can run the bases.

TOMORROW'S GAME: The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive an Angel Pagan bobblehead courtesy of SUNY Downstate... Pagan will be in attendance and throw out the first pitch...The game will be televised on SNY.

PHIL HUGHES: Will begin his minor league rehabilitation assignment with the Staten Island Yankees this evening...Last pitched on April 14th with the NY Yankees vs. Baltimore...Was 0-1 with a 13.94 ERA (16 ER / 10.1 IP) in three starts before being placed on the disabled list with an inflamed right shoulder...According to NY Yankees pitching coach, Larry Rothschild, Hughes should throw four or five innings, and around 60 pitches...Hughes went 18-8 with a 4.19 ERA for the NY Yankees last season and originally selected in the 1st round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

"K" IT AIN'T SO: The Cyclones have struck out 13 times in each of their first two games of the season...Through two games the Cyclones lead the NYPL with 26 K's.

TRAVIS TAIJERON: The Mets 18th round pick in the 2011 MLB Draft is off to a hot start to his professional career...The outfielder ranks third in the NYPL with a .667 (4-6) batting average.

DANNY MUNRO: Made his professional debut on Friday after being selected in the 8th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...Appeared in 258 consecutive games over his four years at Fresno State... Has reached base safely in six of his nine plate appearances this season after ranking among the NCAA leaders in on-base percentage during his senior campaign.

NEW ADDITIONS: Righthander **Tyson Seng** made his pro debut out of the Cyclones bullpen last night...The 33rd round draft pick joined the Cyclones after signing out of the University of Oklahoma...In addition, righthanders **Casey Hauptman** (26th round) and **Randy Fontanez** (27th round) joined the Cyclones last night but did not appear in the game.
