LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones topped the IronBirds by the score of 5-4 at MCU Park... **Brandon Brown** went 2-4 and the Cyclones scored the eventual game-winning run on an infield pop up that was lost in the lights by Aberdeen's Riley Hornback, which allowed **Danny Muno** to score from second for the fifth run of the game...**Steven Winnick** was sharp out of the bullpen, tossing 2.1 perfect innings of relief...**Chris Hilliard** (1-0) became the first Cyclones starter to last 5.0 innings and collected his franchise-record 11th career win in a Brooklyn uniform.

CYCLONES vs. IRONBIRDS: Brooklyn comes into tonight's game with a record of 58-32 against the Aberdeen IronBirds...The 58 wins for the Cyclones is their second highest total against any team in the NYPL (Staten Island-66)... In 2010, the Cyclones went 9-1 against the IronBirds...The last time the IronBirds won a game in Brooklyn was July 28, 2009 after going 0-5 last season.

AT THE GAME TONIGHT: New Jersey Nets head coach **Avery Johnson** will be in attendance to throw out the ceremonial first pitch prior to the 7:00 game...Johnson and the Nets will be moving to Brooklyn and the brand-new Barclays Center for the 2012-2013 season, joining the Cyclones as the only professional sports teams in the borough...In addition the first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Cyclones t-shirt courtesy of CUNY...Following the game it's MidWeek Mayhem where everyone is invited to run the bases after the final out.

TOMORROW'S GAME: Wednesday will be "The Hangover Night" at MCU Park with entertainment themed around the hit movie "The Hangover." In addition the first 2,500 fans in attendance will receive a Luna Park ride pass.

CHRIS HILLIARD: The lefthander moved into sole possession of the Cyclones record for career wins in a Brooklyn uniform with his victory last night...Hilliard won a single-season best nine games for the Cyclones in 2009, and a single game in two starts in 2008 before collecting his 11th win last evening...He had been tied with **Eric Brown** who won three games in 2005 and seven games in 2006.

"K" IT AIN'T SO: The Cyclones struck out nine times on Monday and lead the NYPL with 45 strikeouts through the first four games of the season...Lowell ranks second with 42 K's.

TRAVIS TAIJERON: Has driven in a run in each of his last three games...His only game without an RBI was Opening Day when we went 2-2 with a pair of runs scored.

NEW ADDITIONS: Righthander **Tyson Seng** made his pro debut out of the Cyclones bullpen last night...The 33rd round draft pick joined the Cyclones after signing out of the University of Oklahoma...In addition, righthanders **Casey Hauptman** (26th round) and **Randy Fontanez** (27th round) joined the Cyclones last night but did not appear in the game...With the addition of these three draft picks, there are now seven selections from the 2011 Draft on the roster.

COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION: The Cyclones have welcomed 24,227 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,896,220 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 103,780 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in the history of Minor League Baseball...With two sellouts in three openings this season the Cyclones have drawn standing-room only crowds in 264 of 361 openings at MCU Park.

- Spent the entire 2010 season with the GCL Mets, appearing in 10 games - five as a starter and five in the bullpen.
- Went 3-2 with a 2.84 (10 ER / 27.2 IP) as a starter.
- In his last four starts of the year he went 3-1, pitching atleast 6.0 innings in each outing and allowed more than two runs only once.
- Pitched well under pressure, limiting the opposition to a .182 (14-77) batting average with runners on base, and a .204 (10-49) average with runners in scoring position.
- Did not allow a home run all season in 2010...The last home run he surrendered came on August 17, 2009 with the DSL Mets against the DSL Giants.
- In 2009, went 7-1 as a starter with the DSL Mets...Did not allow more than three earned runs in any of his 12 starts and allowed one earned run or less in nine of 12 outings....Pitched to a 1.74 ERA (13 ER / 67.1 IP).
