LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones won in thrilling fashion on Tuesday night as the team rallied with a pair of runs in the seventh to tie it, and later won the game on a walk-off double from **Luke Stewart...Javier Rodriguez** scored the winning run and also drove in a pair with a double in the seventh inning to knot the game at 2-2...**TJ Chism** collected the win after tossing a scoreless ninth inning...The Cyclones bullpen tossed 5.0 near-perfect innings, as **Casey Hauptman** and **Tyson Seng** combined with Chism to allow only one hit and one walk over 5.0 innings.

CYCLONES vs. IRONBIRDS: Brooklyn comes into tonight's game with a record of 59-32 against the Aberdeen IronBirds...The 59 wins for the Cyclones is their second highest total against any team in the NYPL (Staten Island-66)... In 2010, the Cyclones went 9-1 against the IronBirds...The last time the IronBirds won a game in Brooklyn was July 28, 2009 after going 0-5 last season.

AT THE GAME TONIGHT: The first 2,500 fans in attendance will receive a Luna Park Free Ride Pass courtesy of Luna Park...It will also be "The Hangover Night" featuring themed entertainment from the hit Warner Bros. motion picture which ranks among the highest grossing films of all-time.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones return home on Saturday, June 25th...The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a commemorative baseball featuring the 2010 Cyclones all-stars... In addition, fans will be treated to a special fireworks spectacular following the game.

DANNY MUNO: Was out of the starting lineup yesterday, snapping a string of 221 consecutive starts dating back to his freshman year at Fresno State.

"K" IT AIN'T SO: The Cyclones struck out a season-high 15 times on Tuesday night and lead the NYPL with 60 strikeouts through the first five games of the season...Hudson Valley ranks second with 54 K's.

PUT IT IN PLAY: When the Cyclones do put the ball in play they tend to have success...When a Brooklyn players makes contact, the team is hitting .421 (45-107).

BULLS IN THE PEN: The Cyclones bullpen has been spectacular thus far pitching to a 1.96 ERA (five ER / 23.0 IP)...They have allowed only 15 hits and eight walks while striking out 21.

CORY VAUGHN: Brooklyn Cyclones alum and current Savannah Sand Gnats (A) outfielder participated in the South Atlantic League All-Star Game last night, going 1-2 with a home run as the starting center fielder for the SAL South All-Stars...Vaughn, who set a Cyclones record with 14 home runs in 2010, is hitting .286 with four home runs and 30 RBI in 68 games with Savannah...To start the second half of the 2011 season, Cory Vaughn was promoted to St. Lucie (A) of the Florida State League...Savannah and St. Lucie both won the first half titles for their divisions.

COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION: The Cyclones have welcomed 32,327 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,904,230 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 95,770 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in the history of Minor League Baseball...With two sellouts in three openings this season the Cyclones have drawn standing-room only crowds in 265 of 362 openings at MCU Park.
