LAST NIGHT: Cyclones starter **Carlos Vazquez** pitched 5.0 innings allowing only a pair of hits and **Orlando Tovar**, **Hunter Carnevale** and **TJ Chism** went the rest of the way as Brooklyn defeated Aberdeen 1-0...**Charley Thurber** plated the game's only run with an RBI double in the second inning and the Cyclones collected only one hit after the third frame.

1-0 GAMES: Last night's 1-0 shutout win for the Cyclones was their first nine-inning, 1-0 win since August 20, 2007 when Brooklyn topped the Staten Island Yankees, 1-0...The Cyclones had a 1-0 win vs. Auburn on July 17, 2009 in a game that was called after five innings due to rain...The last 1-0 Cyclones win against Aberdeen came on June 30, 2006 in a 15-inning game in which **Jon Malo** plated the only run with an RBI double...The last 1-0 Cyclones win on the road came on July 4, 2005 at New Jersey as **Kyle Risinger** collected the victory against the now defunct squad.

CYCLONES vs. RENEGADES: Brooklyn comes into tonight's game with an all-time record of 50-39 against the Hudson Valley Renegades...However, the team is 8-14 when traveling to Dutchess Stadium since the 2007 season including 1-6 in their last seven games dating to the start of the 2010 season.

AT THE GAME TONIGHT: The Cyclones will kick off the summer with an end-of-school fireworks show and the only mid week fireworks all-season...The first 3,000 fans in attendance will also have a chance to win game-worn Cyclones jerseys in a scratch off contest.

NEXT HOME GAME: Brooklyn returns to MCU Park on Sunday to take on the Yankees...The Cyclones will close out fireworks week with a Independence Day extravaganza post-game.

ALUMNI UPDATE: **Nick Evans**, a member of the 2005 Brooklyn Cyclones, extended his hitting streak to 18 games with a 2-4 effort for Buffalo last night...Over the 18 games, Evans is hitting a whopping .478 (33-69).

POWER SURGE: After hitting only one home run through the first eight games of the season, the Cyclones have now hit five home runs in their last four games...The six home runs as a team puts them tied with Aberdeen for second in the NYPL behind Lowell, who leads the league with 13.

CALL TO ARMS: The Cyclones pitching staff leads the New York-Penn League with a 2.31 ERA...The team has never allowed more than five runs in a game...Cyclones starting pitchers have a 2.15 ERA (14 ER / 58.2 IP), while the bullpen has pitched to a 2.52 ERA (13 ER/46.1 IP)

COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION: The Cyclones have welcomed 46,845 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,918,838 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 81,162 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in the history of Minor League Baseball...With four sellouts in six openings this season the Cyclones have drawn standing-room only crowds in 266 of 364 openings at MCU Park.
