LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones lost the series finale at Staten Island, 6-5 in 11 innings... **Jeremy Gould** (0-2) suffered the loss after tossing a wild pitch with two outs in the 11th that allowed the winning run to score from second... The Cyclones rallied from three down to tie the score at 5-5 in the eighth... Brooklyn committed a season-high four errors... **Javier Rodriguez** hit his third home run of the season.

CYCLONES vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones have compiled a record of 35-14 against the Vermont Lake Monsters/Expos in franchise history... Brooklyn went 5-1 against Vermont last season... The 2011 season marks the first year that Vermont has been an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics.

AT THE GAME TONIGHT: Reggy the Purple Party Dude will entertain the crowd... In addition following the game all fans will be invited to run the bases... It is also Social Media Madness with "Tweet Your Seat" contests, and prizes for fans who "Check In."

NEXT HOME GAME: Tomorrow night will be Irish Heritage Night at the ballpark and the start of Jersey Thursdays... The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Brooklyn Irish jersey courtesy of Budweiser... In addition, the Cyclones will be wearing special Irish Jerseys and hats... The jerseys will be raffled off with the proceeds to benefit the Ancient Order of Hibernians.

POWER SURGE: Last night, Javier Rodriguez hit Brooklyn's 15th home run of the season, which ranks them second in the league behind Lowell's 17... The Cyclones have hit home runs in four straight games and after hitting just one home run through the first eight games of the season, Brooklyn has now hit 14 home runs in their last 11 games.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Outfielder **Javier Rodriguez** leads the NYPL in doubles (8) and extra base hits (11)... He is second in the league with 17 RBI and tied for third with three home runs... As a team, Brooklyn's pitching staff leads the league with a 2.43 ERA, over half a run lower than second place Staten Island.

WHO'S HOT: **Javier Rodriguez** is hitting .311 (14-45) over his last 10 games with nine runs scored and 11 RBI... **Brian Harrison** is hitting .371 (13-35) over his last nine games.

WHO'S NOT: Amauris Valdez is 0-11 over his last three games... Brandon Brown is 1-13 over his last three games.

TUESDAY'S CHILDREN: Prior to tonight's game, Tuesday's Children will be participating in the Cyclones Field of Dreams program... There will be 65 children of first responders from the September 11th attack that take the field with the Cyclones players... Tuesday's Children is a non-profit organization that offers guidance and mentoring to children affected by terrorism.
