**LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones fell to Vermont, 5-2 at MCU Park on Wednesday...**Charley Thurber** collected his third straight multi-hit game and **Jonathan Clark** went 2-5 to collect his first multi-hit game as a pro...The cyclones committed three errors and an errant throw by **Carlos Leyva** failed to complete a double play and led to three runs by Vermont.

**CYCLONES vs. VERMONT:** The Cyclones have compiled a record of 35-15 against the Vermont Lake Monsters/Expos in franchise history...Brooklyn went 5-1 against Vermont last season...The 2011 season marks the first year that Vermont has been an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics.

**AT THE GAME TONIGHT:** It's the return of Jersday Thursday as the first 3,000 people in attendance receive Brooklyn Irish Jerseys courtesy of Budweiser...In addition, it is Irish Heritage Night and the Cyclones will be wearing special jerseys and caps to go along with the festivities... The jerseys will be raffled off during the game with proceeds to benefit the Ancient Order of Hibernians.

**NEXT HOME GAME:** Brooklyn will close out their three game set with the Lake Monsters on Friday...The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Cyclones Visor courtesy of Pepsi...It is also Friday Night Fireworks on Coney Island where fans can enjoy the post-game fireworks from the comfort of their seat.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to today's game, OF **Dylan Brown**, INF **Carlos Leyva** and 1B **Luke Stewart** were assigned to Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League...The team also activated SS **Danny Munro** and 2B **J.B. Brown** from the Disabled List, and added LHP **Jack Leathersich** to the active roster.

**TRAVIS TAIJERON:** The Cyclones outfielder is hitting .421 (8-19) with five runs scored and five RBI in his last six games...He also ranks second among NYPL outfielders with three assists this season...Prior to heating up recently, Taijeron was 2-20 dating from June 21st-29th.

**CHARLEY THURBER:** Is hitting .538 (7-13) over his last three games and has three RBI over this span as well.

**DANNY MUNO:** Returns to the active roster tonight after being out since injuring his right ring finger on June 25th...The former Fresno State Bulldog did not miss a single game in four years of college.

**POWER SURGE:** Last night, Javier Rodriguez hit Brooklyn's 15th home run of the season, which ranks them second in the league behind Lowell's 17...The Cyclones have hit home runs in four straight games and after hitting just one home run through the first eight games of the season, Brooklyn has now hit 14 home runs in their last 11 games.
