LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones lost their third straight, and second at the hands of the Vermont Lake Monsters, with a 5-4 defeat on Thursday night...**Brandon Brown** hit his fourth home run of the season, a three-run blast, to give Brooklyn an early lead....But Vermont rallied, scoring three runs in the seventh off of **Orlando Tovar**, who suffered the loss.

CYCLONES vs. VERMONT: The Cyclones have compiled a record of 35-16 against the Vermont Lake Monsters/Expos in franchise history...Brooklyn went 5-1 against Vermont last season...The 2011 season marks the first year that Vermont has been an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics.

AT THE GAME TONIGHT: The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Cyclones Visor courtesy of Pepsi Max...In addition, fans are invited to stay in their seat and enjoy a post-game fireworks show (weather permitting).

NEXT HOME GAME: Brooklyn returns to MCU Park on Wednesday, July 13th to open a six-game homestand...It will be NYPD Night and the first 3,000 fans will receive an Officer Sandy Bobblehead courtesy of MCU...That game will also be broadcasted on WFAN as well as SNY.

ROSTER MOVES: After last night's game 2B **J.B. Brown** was sent to St. Lucie (A) of the Florida State League...**IB Cole Frenzel** reported to Brooklyn today after being selected in the 7th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...Frenzel was recently named All-West Region First Team after hitting .356 with 13 doubles, six triples, three home runs, 48 runs scored and 48 RBI in 60 games with the University of Arizona...He reached base in 59 straight games from 2010 through 2011.

WELCOME HOME HEROES: The Cyclones and the Brooklyn Wall of Remembrance have joined to start the "Welcome Home Heroes" project at every home game this season...Tonight's home town hero will be **Ben Kotwica** who serves as the Assistant Special Teams coach for the New York Jets, he also spent eight years in the Army after graduating from West Point... He served our country as a platoon leader, and Apache Helicopter Pilot, receiving the Bronze Star and numerous other awards for his service.

NO "E" IN WIN: The Cyclones have lost four of their last five games and have committed 11 errors in these four losses over the span.

POWER SURGE: Last night, Brandon Brown hit his fourth home run of the season, a three run blast...It was the 16th home run of the season for Brooklyn which ranks them second in the league behind Lowell's 17...The Cyclones have hit home runs in five of their last six games and after hitting just one home run through the first eight games of the season, Brooklyn has now hit 15 home runs in their last 13 games.
