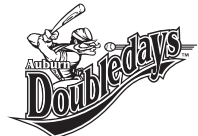

LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones opened their six-game homestand with a 9-3 loss at the hands of the Auburn Doubledays...Auburn jumped out to an 8-0 lead after three innings but Tyson Seng, Casey Hauptman, Wilfredo Tovar, and Jeremy Gould combined their relief efforts to toss 6.2 innings of one-run ball. The only yielded run came on a throwing error. Brooklyn's offense strung together two runs in the fourth inning, but only plated one run the rest of the way.

CYCLONES VS. AUBURN: Brooklyn is 17-16 all-time against the Auburn Doubledays and 0-2 in the playoffs...In 2010 the Cyclones went 1-2 against the Doubledays...The 2011 season marks their first as an affiliate of the Washington Nationals.

AT THE GAME TONIGHT: Thursday is Jersday Thursday and the first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Cycloes Red, White & Blue Jersey courtesy of St. Francis College...In addition 33 children will be receiving their US Citizenship on the field prior to this evening's game...The children range from 6 to 15 and hail from 16 different countries including Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, St. Lucia, Ukraine, Yemen, China, Columbia, Guyana, Haiti and India.

NEXT HOME GAME: On Friday, the first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Black and Teal Cyclones hat. Fans will also be invited to stick around after the conclusion of tomorrow's game for a Fireworks Show.

BELOW .500: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with a record of 12-13...It marks the first time that the Cyclones have been below .500 since July 29, 2008 when they were 20-21 following a 4-3 win over the Vermont Lake Monsters...Brooklyn went on to finish that season 45-30 and make the playoffs.

HOME LOSING STREAK: The Cyclones have lost their last five games at home...The five game losing streak is the longest since the 2005 season when the Cyclones lost six straight home games, from July 5th-15th, which is the franchise record for longest home losing streak.

NO "E" IN WIN: The Cyclones have lost eight of their last 10 games and have committed 17 errors in these eight losses over the span.

THE NEED FOR SPEED: Brooklyn currently ranks last in the NYPL with only 10 stolen bases in 24 games...Mahoning Valley, Lowell and Vermont are tied for the league lead with 44 swipes...The Cyclones are on the only team in the league with less than 18 stolen bases.

WHO'S HOT: Danny Muno extended his hitting streak to five games last night with a 1-for-4, one run effort...The shortstop is hitting .421 (8-for-19) with three doubles.

NOT SO HOT JULY: The Cyclones are 3-8 since the calendar turned to July...They have been outscored 47-41 and are hitting just .249 (96-386) while the opposition is hitting .269 against Cyclones pitching.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a 2.57 ERA as a team...They have allowed only 86 runs in 222.1 innings, but 18 of the 86 (20.9%) have been unearned.

COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION: The Cyclones have welcomed 75,240 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,947,233 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 52,767 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in the history of Minor League Baseball.

- His nine strikeouts on 7/02 is a season-high for a Cyclones pitcher.
- Currently tied for second for the NYPL lead in strikeouts.
- Set a career high for strikeouts in an appearance with 10 as a member of Kingsport (R) in 2009.
- Contributed seven of Brooklyn's fifteen strikeouts vs. Vermont on 7/07. The Lake Monsters pitching staff also recorded 15 strikeouts to bring the grand total of punchouts on the night to 30.
- Posted a 5-1 record with an ERA of 3.79 with Kingsport (R) in 2009. Also recorded 57 strikeouts in 61.2 of work.
- Has held the opposition to a .188 batting average so far in 2011. Runners in scoring position are faring even worse, hitting just .182 (4-for-22) against him.
- Four of his six earned runs allowed have come in the third inning.
