LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones rallied from a 4-0 deficit to defeat the Lowell Spinners 5-4 on Saturday night...**Nelfi Zapata** tied the Cyclones franchise record with three doubles and went 3-4 with two runs scored and two RBI... **Orlando Tovar, T.J. Chism** and **Hunter Carnevale** combined to throw 7.1 scoreless innings of relief...Chism (2-0) collected the win and Carnevale picked up his second save of the year.

CYCLONES VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with a record of 30-20 against the Lowell Spinners...The Cyclones went 5-1 against Lowell in 2010 including 3-0 at MCU Park...The last game that the Spinners won at MCU Park was September 6, 2009.

AT THE GAME TONIGHT: The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Cyclones power bracelet...It's also Jewish Heritage Night...In addition fans are invited onto the field prior to the game for a pre-game catch and following the game it will be kids run the bases...Lastly, Toodee from the hit show "Yo Gabba Gabba" will be in attendance taking pictures with fans and roaming the ballpark.

NEXT HOME GAME: Monday will be the first of two day games at MCU Park this summer...It will be camp day as several thousand children will be in attendance with their summer camps...It is also Meet the Cyclones Monday and fans will be allowed to go on to the field and meet their favorite players following the game.

THE NEED FOR SPEED: Brooklyn currently ranks last in the NYPL with only 12 stolen bases in 27 games...Vermont leads the league with 54 swipes and Lowell ranks second with 51...The Cyclones are on the only team in the league with less than 23 stolen bases.

WHO'S HOT: Since returning from the Disabled List **Danny Muno** has been on fire, hitting .429 (12-28) over his last eight games...He has reached base safely in 20 of his 36 plate appearances over this period...**Charley Thurber** is hitting .303 (10-33) over his last nine games...**Richard Lucas** is hitting .344 (11-32) in his last nine games as well.

WHO'S NOT: **Travis Taijeron** is 0-13 in his last four games and a 1-20 dating to July 7th... After hitting in 12 straight games, **Javier Rodriguez** is now hitting just .105 (2-19) over his last five games...**Ismael Tijerina** is hitting .08 (2-23) over his last six games with an at-bat.

NO BULL: The Cyclones bullpen tossed 7.1 scoreless innings in last night's game and collected their seventh win of the season...In 120.2 innings, they have allowed only 34 runs...The bullpen has inherited 38 total runners during the season and allowed only four to score.

COLE FRENZEL: Went 1-4 and scored the game-winning run with an RBI single in the sixth inning...The Mets 7th round pick in 2011 has six RBI in his last four games and has three multi-hit games in seven starts for the cyclones.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a 2.74 ERA as a team...They have allowed only 94 runs in 249.1 innings, but 18 of the 94 (19.1%) have been unearned.

COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION: The Cyclones have welcomed 99,806 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,971,799 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 28,201 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in the history of Minor League Baseball.
