LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones won their fourth in a row, defeating Lowell 4-1...The Cyclones bullpen of **Casey Hauptman**, **Todd Weldon**, **Tyson Seng** and **Jeremy Gould** combined for 6.0 shutout innings of relief...**Richard Lucas** went 2-3 with a pair of runs scored and connected on a two-run blast in the eighth inning to give the Cyclones some breathing room.

CYCLONES VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones come into tonight's game with a record of 31-20 against the Lowell Spinners...The Cyclones went 5-1 against Lowell in 2010 including 3-0 at MCU Park...The last game that the Spinners won at MCU Park was September 6, 2009.

AT THE GAME TODAY: It will be Camp Day at MCU Park on Monday afternoon...Following the games fans will be allowed onto the field for "Meet the Cyclones Monday" with autographs and photos on the field.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones return home on Thursday, July 21st for the first of two against the Aberdeen IronBirds...It will be Jersday Thursday and the first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Red Cyclones Jersey courtesy of Verizon.

COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION: The Cyclones have welcomed 105,430 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,977,423 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 22,577 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in the history of Minor League Baseball.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a 2.68 ERA as a team...They have allowed only 95 runs in 258.1 innings, but 18 of the 95 (18.9%) have been unearned.

WHO'S HOT: Since returning from the Disabled List **Danny Muno** has been on fire, hitting .375 (12-32) over his nine eight games...He has reached base safely in 20 of his 40 plate appearances over this period...**Richard Lucas** is hitting .387 (12-31) with seven runs scored.

NO BULL: The Cyclones bullpen has tossed 13.1 consecutive scoreless innings over the last two games...For the season, inn 126.2 innings, they have allowed only 34 runs...The bullpen has inherited 40 total runners during the season and allowed only four to score.

COLE FRENZEL: Over his last five games the Cyclones first baseman is hitting .353 (6-17) with five runs scored and six RBI.

WIN STREAK: The Cyclones have won four straight games, tying their season-high from June 19th-22nd...Over the four games they have out scored opponents 21-9...They have also committed only two errors in these four games...The Cyclones had lost six of their previous seven and committed 16 errors in these games.

JOSE REYES: Mets shortstop and four-time National League All-Star **Jose Reyes** will play for the Cyclones on Monday as part of his minor league rehabilitation assignment...Reyes was placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on July 6th with a strained left hamstring...Despite missing the last two weeks of the season, the 28-year-old still leads the Major Leagues in triples (15), average (.354), and multi-hit games (43)...His 30 stolen bases ranks second in the major leagues and is 18 more than the Cyclones have as a team during the 2011 season...Reyes becomes the 13th New York Met to play with the Cyclones as part of a rehabilitation assignment and the first since **Carlos Beltran** who played in five games with the Cyclones from September 2-6, 2009.
