LAST NIGHT: For the second night in a row, the Cyclones rallied from an early deficit, but this time they were never able to take the lead, falling 7-6 in 10 innings...**Richard Lucas** tied the game with an RBI single in the top of the ninth and **Brandon Brown** hit his fifth home run of the season to pace the offense...**Casey Hauptman** suffered the loss after allowing a single run in the bottom of the 10th.

CYCLONES VS. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 6-2 against Aberdeen this season including 3-0 at MCU Park...The IronBirds have not won a game in Brooklyn since July 28, 2009 when they defeated the Cyclones 2-1...All-time, Brooklyn is 63-34 against Aberdeen.

JERSEY OFF THE BACK: Today and tomorrow the Cyclones will be wearing alternate jerseys that will be auctioned off for charities... Tonight the team will be wearing Stars & Stripes Jerseys that will be auctioned off to benefit Family, Morale, Welfare and Recreation at Fort Hamilton Army Base...Tomorrow the team will wear special jerseys for FDNY Night that will be auctioned off to benefit the World Police & Fire Games coming to New York and MCU Park in August.

AT THE GAME TODAY: It's Jersday Thursday at MCU Park and the first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Red Cyclones Jersey courtesy of Verizon....Following the game, all fans are invited to run the bases...It is also Military Appreciation Night.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones close out their two game series with the IronBirds on Friday night with FDNY Night...The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Cyclones Visor courtesy of Pepsi Max...There will also be a post-game fireworks show

COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION: The Cyclones have welcomed 113,592 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,985,549 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 14,451 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in the history of Minor League Baseball.

VS. ABERDEEN: Cyclones second baseman **Brandon Brown** is hitting .375 (9-25) with two home runs and six runs scored in six games against the IronBirds this season...Outfielder **Javier Rodriguez** is hitting .357 (10-28) with seven runs scored in seven games.

WHO'S HOT: Infielder **Richard Lucas** is hitting .406 (13-32) over the last 10 games with 12 runs scored, two home runs and six RBI... In his last five games, catcher **Nelfi Zapata** is hitting .417 (5-12).

WHO'S NOT: Shortstop **Danny Muno** has cooled down after a torrid start to the season... The 8th round pick in the 2011 draft is 3-18 over his last four games and has six strikeouts over that period.

STOLEN BASES: The IronBirds have stolen 10 bases in the last two games against the Cyclones...In the first 30 games of the season, Brooklyn had only allowed 30 stolen bases...The IronBirds had compiled 29 stolen bases in their first 31 games prior to the recent speed burst.

NO BULL: Over the last five games the Cyclones bullpen has compiled a 1.53 ERA...In 29.1 innings in these five games they have allowed only five runs...Over the same period, Cyclones starters have allowed 22 runs in 16.0 innings for a 12.38 ERA.

- Collected his first win of the season on July 4th at Staten Island...Struck out a season-high six in that start.
- Made his first start of the season on June 19th vs. Staten Island, opposite Phil Hughes, who was on a minor league rehabilitation assignment...Did not factor in the decision, but the Cyclones won, 5-3.
- Made three appearances, two starts with Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League in 2010, going 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA (nine ER/10.0 innings pitched)
- Was the Mets 7th round selection in 2010 out of the University of Georgia.
- During his senior season with the Bulldogs went 2-6 in 18 games, 13 starts.
- Struck out 55 over 68.1 innings on the mound.
- Had a career-high eight strikeouts at #4 Florida on May 15, 2010 over 6.0 innings of work.
- Was also selected in the 17th round of the 2009 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles but did not sign.
