**LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones pounded out 13 runs on a season-high 20 hits in a 13-0 shut-out victory over the Aberdeen IronBirds on Thursday evening...**Richard Lucas** went 5-6 with four runs scored and **Travis Taijeron** added a 4-4 effort with five RBI...**Danny Muno** hit his first professional home run in the win...**Jeff Walters** (2-2), **Steven Winnick**, and **Eric Beaulac** combined on the Cyclones third shutout of the season.

**CYCLONES VS. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones are 7-2 against Aberdeen this season including 4-0 at MCU Park...The IronBirds have not won a game in Brooklyn since July 28, 2009 when they defeated the Cyclones 2-1...All-time, Brooklyn is 64-34 against Aberdeen.

**JERSEY OFF THE BACK:** Tonight, the team will wear special jerseys for FDNY Night that will be auctioned off to benefit the World Police & Fire Games coming to New York and MCU Park in August.

**AT THE GAME TODAY:** It's FDNY Night at the ballpark...The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Cyclones visor courtesy of Pepsi Max...Post-Game Fireworks and Jersey off the Back raffle.

**NEXT HOME GAME:** The Cyclones return to MCU Park on Wednesday for the first of a three game series against the Connecticut Tigers.

**COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION:** The Cyclones have welcomed 118, 317 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,990,274 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 9,726 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in MILB history.

**VS. ABERDEEN:** Cyclones second baseman **Brandon Brown** is hitting .393 (11-28) with two home runs and seven runs scored in seven games against the IronBirds this season...Outfielder **Javier Rodriguez** is hitting .344 (11-32) with nine runs scored in eight games...**Brian Harrison** is hitting .343 (12-35) with seven RBI in nine games.

**HOT BATS:** In their last 10 games the Cyclones are hitting .285 (97-340) and averaging 6.3 runs a game...In the 23 games prior to this stretch, Brooklyn was hitting .248 (196-791) as a team and averaging 4.13 runs per game.

**RICHARD LUCAS:** The Cyclones third baseman has been the hottest player in the New York-Penn League over the last 10 games...The 2007 fourth round pick is hitting .474 (18-38) over his last 10 games...Over his last five he has been even hotter, hitting .571 (12-21) with 12 runs scored.

**WHO'S HOT:** Outfielder **Travis Taijeron** is hitting .471 (8-17) over the last five games with eight RBI...**Brandon Brown** is hitting .438 (7-16) over the last five...**Brian Harrison** is hitting .375 (6-16) over the same span.

**NO BULL:** Over the last six games the Cyclones bullpen has compiled a 1.39 ERA...In 32.1 innings in these six games they have allowed only five runs...Over the same period, Cyclones starters have allowed 22 runs in 22.0 innings for a 9.00 ERA.

**TRANSACTION:** Following last night's game, outfielder **Jonathan Clark** was assigned to Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League...Clark was hitting .143 (5-35) in 12 games with Brooklyn.

- Made his first pro start on July 17th vs. Lowell...Went 3.0 innings and received a no-decision allowing one run in the Cyclones 4-1 victory over the Spinners
