**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones rallied for five runs in the top of the ninth and ran away with a 9-5 victory over the State College Spikes on Monday night...**Travis Taijeron** connected on a grand-slam in the ninth and finished the game 3-4...**Danny Muno** added a 3-5 effort with two runs scored to set the table for the Cyclones...**Tyson Seng** (1-1) collected the win and **Todd Weldon** recorded the last out of the game to get the save.

**CYCLONES VS. CONNECTICUT:** The Cyclones went 1-2 on their trip to Connecticut earlier this season...All-time the Cyclones are 5-4 against the Tigers since they moved from Oneonta.

**AT THE GAME TODAY:** The Cyclones will welcome their 3,000,000th fan to MCU Park this evening, reaching the milestone faster than any short season franchise in Minor League Baseball history...That one lucky fan will have the chance to win \$30,000 following the game...Tonight will also be Christmas in July featuring prizes for fans as a thank you for helping us reach the 3,000,000 fans milestone.

**NEXT HOME GAME:** It will be Jersday Thursday and the first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Black & Blue Cyclones Jersey... Following the game it will be EVERYONE runs the bases.

**COUNTDOWN TO THREE MILLION:** The Cyclones have welcomed 123,699 fans so far this year...With a grand total of 2,995,656 fans that have entered MCU Park since its inception in 2001, the Cyclones are just 4,344 fans shy of the 3,000,000 mark - reaching the milestone quicker than any Short Season franchise in Minor League Baseball history.

**HOT BATS:** In their last 14 games the Cyclones are hitting .291 (142-488) and averaging 6.6 runs a game...In the 23 games prior to this stretch, Brooklyn was hitting .248 (196-791) as a team and averaging 4.13 runs per game.

**T-PAIN:** Cyclones Outfielder **Travis Taijeron** has been tearing un the NYPL...Over the last 10 games, the Mets 18th round pick in 2011 is hitting .438 (14-32) with 16 RBI...In his last five games, Travis is hitting .526 (10-19) with three home runs and 13 RBI.

**RUN RICHARD:** Cyclones third baseman **Richard Lucas** ranks second in the NYPL with 28 runs scored this season...Over the last 10 games he has scored 17 times and is hitting .441 (15-34) over the span...Lucas has reached base safely in each of his last 16 games dating to July 7th.

**DANNY MUNO:** Is hitting .520 (13-25) over his last five games and currently leads the NYPL in hitting .375 (36-96) and on-base percentage (.469)...When Muno scores a run the Cyclones are 9-4 this season.

**JACK LEATHERSICH:** The Mets fifth round draft pick in 2011 has been nearly unhittable this season...In four appearances, all 1.0 inning of relief due to an inning restriction placed on him, he has struck out 10 batters and allowed only one hit...During his final season at UMass-Lowell, he struck out 126 in 89.0 innings.

**NO BULL:** Over the last 10 games the Cyclones bullpen has compiled a 1.74 ERA... In 46.2 innings in these 10 games they have allowed only nine runs...Over the same period, Cyclones starters have allowed 31 earned runs in 42.2 innings for a 6.54 ERA.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER : RHP # 18 Jeff Walters (2-2, 3.45 ERA)

- Tossed a season-high 6.0 innings in a 13-0 victory over the Aberdeen IronBirds on 7/21...Allowed only one hit while walking a pair.
- Collected his first win of the season on July 4th at Staten Island...Struck out a season-high six in that start.
- Made his first start of the season on June 19th vs. Staten Island, opposite Phil Hughes, who was on a minor league rehabilitation assignment...Did not factor in the decision, but the Cyclones won, 5-3.
- Made three appearances, two starts with Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League in 2010, going 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA (nine ER/10.0 innings pitched)
- Was the Mets 7th round selection in 2010 out of the University of Georgia.
- During his senior season with the Bulldogs went 2-6 in 18 games, 13 starts.
- Struck out 55 over 68.1 innings on the mound.
- Was also selected in the 17th round of the 2009 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles but did not sign.
