LAST GAME: The Brooklyn Cyclones welcomed their 3,000,000th fan to MCU Park on Wednesday night, but they were topped by the Connecticut Tigers by a score of 9-6...Brooklyn trailed from the third inning on, but they rallied for four runs in the seventh inning and brought the tying-run to the plate in the ninth...

Jeff Walters was tagged for four earned runs in 4.0 innings and was tagged with the loss...**Xorge Carillo** and **Danny Muno** each connected on a home run while **Richard Lucas** added a 2-4 effort with a pair of doubles.

CYCLONES VS. CONNECTICUT: The Cyclones are now 1-3 against Connecticut this season...They went 1-2 on their trip to Connecticut earlier this season...All-time the Cyclones are 5-5 against the Tigers since they moved from Oneonta.

AT THE GAME TODAY: It will be Jersday Thursday and the first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Black & Blue Cyclones Jersey...Following the game it will be EVERYONE runs the bases...It will also be Country night and one lucky fan will have the chance to win an all-expense paid trip to the Rocking Horse Ranch.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones will close out their three game set with the Tigers on Friday evening...It will be EMS Appreciation night with the first 3,000 fans in attendance receiving a Cyclones Performance Shirt courtesy of Midwood Ambulance...Fans in attendance will also get to enjoy the Coney Island Fireworks following the game.

3,000,000 AND GROWING: The Cyclones welcomed their 3,000,000th fan to MCU Park on Wednesday, July 27th reaching the milestone quicker than any short season franchise in Minor League Baseball history.

HOT BATS: In their last 15 games the Cyclones are hitting .289 (151-523) and averaging 6.2 runs a game...In the 23 games prior to this stretch, Brooklyn was hitting .248 (196-791) as a team and averaging 4.13 runs per game.

T-PAIN: Cyclones Outfielder **Travis Taijeron** has been tearing up the NYPL...Over his last nine games, the Mets 18th round pick in 2011 is hitting .429 (15-35) with 16 RBI.

RUN RICHARD: Cyclones third baseman **Richard Lucas** ranks second in the NYPL with 29 runs scored this season...Over the last 12 games he has scored 19 times and is hitting .500 (21-42) over the span...Has reached base safely in each of his last 17 games dating to July 7th.

DANNY MUNO: Is riding a six-game hitting streak...Hitting .500 (15-30) over the span and currently leads the NYPL in hitting .375 (38-101) and on-base percentage (.466)...Defensively, the shortstop has not committed an error in his last 13 games after having six errors in his first 12 games.

JACK LEATHERSICH: The Mets fifth round draft pick in 2011 has been nearly unhittable this season...In four appearances, all 1.0 inning of relief due to an inning restriction placed on him, he has struck out 10 batters and allowed only one hit...During his final season at UMass-Lowell, he struck out 126 in 89.0 innings...Jack will make his first pro start on Sunday in Vermont.

NO BULL: Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 51 runners and allowing only five of them to score (9.8%)...By comparison, the Atlanta Braves bullpen lead MLB with a 21.5% (31-144).

- Made his first pro start on July 17th vs. Lowell...Went 3.0 innings and received a no-decision allowing one run in the Cyclones 4-1 victory over the Spinners.
- Made his professional debut on June 26th at Aberdeen...Tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief.
- Selected in the 27th round of the 2011 MLB draft out of the Univ. of South Florida.
- Led USF in games started (14), innings pitched (95.2), strikeouts (74), and ERA (2.92).
- Went 5-6 and was named to the second team All-Big East...Became the first player in conference history to be named to the All-Big East team three years straight.
