LAST GAME: The Cyclones won a thriller on Thursday night, as **Travis Taijeron's** solo home run in the bottom of the ninth was the difference maker as Brooklyn defeated Connecticut 2-1... **Richard Lucas** also hit his fourth home run of the season earlier in the game...**T.J. Chism** (3-0) collected the win after pitching a scoreless ninth...**Todd Weldon** struck out five in his 2.1 innings of scoreless relief...**Randy Fontanez** made the start and went 4.2 innings.

CYCLONES VS. CONNECTICUT: The Cyclones are now 2-3 against Connecticut this season...They went 1-2 on their trip to Connecticut earlier this season...All-time the Cyclones are 6-5 against the Tigers since they moved from Oneonta.

AT THE GAME TODAY: It is EMS Appreciation Night with the first 3,000 fans in attendance receiving a Cyclones Performance T-Shirt courtesy of Midwood Ambulance...There will also be post-game fireworks that light up the sky.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones will return to MCU Park on Tuesday, August 2nd and begin a three-game series against the Williamsport Crosscutters...The Inflatamaniacs will make their MCU Park debut and following the game, everyone gets to run the bases.

DILLON GEE NIGHT: On Thursday, August 4th former Cyclone hurler and current New York Mets pitcher Dillon Gee will be on hand for a special pre-game ceremony.

3,000,000 AND GROWING: The Cyclones welcomed their 3,000,000th fan to MCU Park on Wednesday, July 27th reaching the milestone quicker than any short season franchise in Minor League Baseball history.

HOT BATS: In their last 10 games the Cyclones are hitting .296 (110-371) and averaging 7.3 runs a game...In the 29 games prior to this stretch, Brooklyn was hitting .249 (242-972) as a team and averaging 4.21 runs per game.

T-PAIN: Cyclones Outfielder **Travis Taijeron** has been tearing un the NYPL...Over his last ten games, the Mets 18th round pick in 2011 is hitting .412 (14-34) with 17 RBI and four home runs -- two of which were game-deciders that came in the ninth inning.

RUN RICHARD: Cyclones third baseman **Richard Lucas** ranks second in the NYPL with 30 runs scored this season...Over the last 13 games he has scored 20 times and is hitting .489 (22-45) over the span...Has reached base safely in each of his last 18 games dating to July 7th.

DANNY MUNO: Is riding a seven-game hitting streak...He's hitting .471 (16-34) over the span and currently leads the NYPL in batting average -- .371 (39-105) -- and on-base percentage (.459)...Defensively, the shortstop has not committed an error in his last 14 games after having six errors in his first 12 games.

BRK ON TOP: Brooklyn owns several of the NYPL's leader columns. **Danny Muno** and **Richard Lucas** sit atop the league in both batting average and on-base percentage. **Travis Taijeron** overtook the slugging percentage lead last night with his walk-off home run. **T.J. Chism's** 16 appearances are tied for most in the NYPL.

NO BULL: Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 51 runners and allowing only five of them to score (9.8%)...By comparison, the Atlanta Braves bullpen lead MLB with a 21.5 % (31-144).
