LAST GAME: The Cyclones won the first game of the four game set, defeating the Staten Island Yankees 9-4 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark on Friday night...**Tyson Seng** (3-1) got the win after tossing 1.2 innings of scoreless relief...**Richard Lucas** was the offensive star, going 2-5 with four RBI and two runs scored... **Travis Taijeron** added a 2-4 effort with a pair of RBI.

CYCLONES VS. YANKEES: The 2011 season series is tied at 4-4 after last night's Brooklyn win...Overall, the Cyclones are 68-66 against Staten Island since joining the league in 2001.

VS. YANKEES: Shortstop **Danny Munro** is hitting .429 (6-14) with five runs scored and five walks in four games against Staten Island this season...Munro missed the July 2nd-5th series with an injured finger...Outfielder **Travis Taijeron** is hitting .500 (10-20) with three runs scored, two doubles, one triple, one home run and six RBI in six games against SI.

AT THE GAME TODAY: Today is National Mustard Day and there will be several mustard themed activities on the concourse throughout the game...There will also be post-game fireworks shot from the outfield presented by The Hospital for Special Surgery.

NEXT HOME GAME: The Cyclones will close out the four game series against the Staten Island Yankees with Italian Heritage Night...The first 3,000 fans will receive a Brooklyn Pride T-Shirt courtesy of Lutheran Medical Center... Following the game fans will also be invited on to the field for a special autograph and photo session as part of Meet the Cyclones Monday.

CHARLES IN CHARGE: Cyclones outfielder **Charley Thurber** is hitting .316 (12-38) over his last 12 games...Since starting his pro career 6-34 through his first nine games, Thurber is hitting .333 (32-96) since July 4th.

T-PAIN: Cyclones Outfielder **Travis Taijeron** has 42 hits this season with 21 of them going for extra-bases...He is hitting .357 (25-70) since July 17th with 13 of his 25 hits going for extra bases...For the season he is hitting .381 (16-42) from the seventh inning on.

NOT SO HOT ROD: Cyclones outfielder **Javier Rodriguez** is hitting .103 (3-29) over his last 10 games...Over this span he has walked 12 times...All four of his hits since July 25th have gone for extra bases - three doubles and one triple.

RISP: The Cyclones have been struggling with runners in scoring position over their last 11 games, batting .182 (16-88) including a 4-16 effort in last night's game.

WON AND DONE: Cyclones starters have combined for just one win since July 15th. In 21 starts since July 15th, the rotation is 1-7 with a 5.06 ERA (50 ER / 89.0 IP) over the span.

NO BULL: Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 56 runners and allowing only seven of them to score (12.5%)...By comparison, the Atlanta Braves bullpen leads MLB with a 21.6 % (32-148).

ROSTER MOVES: The Cyclones placed **Nelfi Zapata** on the Disabled List and added **C Tyler Carpenter** and **INF T.J. Rivera** to the roster.
