**LAST GAME:** The Cyclones were rained out on Sunday in Mahoning Valley, in what was scheduled to be their last game prior to the All-Star Break...The Cyclones went 4-1 in their five game road trip prior to the break.

**CYCLONES VS. JAMMERS:** The Cyclones are 18-13 all-time against Jamestown...In 2001, the Cyclones played the first game in franchise history against the Jamestown Jammers at Diethrick Park on June 19th...It was a 2-1 win.

**AT THE GAME TODAY:** It's BrooklynNite as we celebrate the best borough in the greatest city in the world...The first 3,000 fans in attendance will receive a Brooklyn Rally towel and we will have a number of Brooklynites including John Franco - in attendance.

**NEXT HOME GAME:** Thursday will be New York Football Night and the first 3,000 fans in attendance will have the choice of a Green or Blue Cyclones Football Jersey as we hold a Jersey-Lecture to see which color rules the gridiron in NYC...Former Jet Marty Lyons and former Giant George Martin will be on hand to sign autographs as the Cyclones raise funds for the Marty Lyons Foundation and the NFL Alumni Assoc.

**ALL-STARS:** The Cyclones had seven players named to the New York-Penn League All-Star team, and represented the National League affiliates last night in Lowell...The NL Defeated the AL 7-3...Charley Thurber started in right field and went 0-4...Richard Lucas went 0-2...Danny Muno went 1-2 with a key two-RBI double in the top of the ninth...TJ Chism and Todd Welton each tossed 0.2 scoreless innings...Travis Tajeron and Tyson Seng did not play.

**THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS:** The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a .971 fielding percentage...They have committed a league low 60 errors in 56 games.

**CHARLEY DOWN:** Cyclones outfielder Charley Thurber is 2-20 over his last five games...During the month of August he is batting just .204 (10-49) and has seen his batting average drop from .303 to .269.

**MUNO ON THE MONEY:** Cyclones short-stop Danny Muno has scored a run in each of his last five games...Since returning from the Disabled List on July 7th, he is hitting .345 (49-142)...Since July 15th, when Muno scores a run the Cyclones are 12-2...For the season Brooklyn is 16-6 when Muno scores a run.

**HOT ROD:** Brooklyn outfielder Javier Rodriguez is hitting .357 (10-28) over his last seven games with four multi-hit contests and nine RBI over the span...Prior to his recent hot streak, J-Rod was 3-33 over his previous 11 contests.

**START ME UP:** During the Cyclones five game road trip, during which the team went 4-1, Cyclones starters collected three wins after having only one between July 16th and August 8th... Over the last five games, Cyclones starters have pitched to a 1.80 ERA (five earned runs / 25.0 innings).

**NO BULL:** Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 67 runners and allowing only 14 of them to score (20.89%)...By comparison, the San Francisco Giants bullpen leads MLB with a 21.2 % (38-179).

## TONIGHT'S STARTER : RHP # 32 Marco Camarena (2-3, 3.40 ERA)

- Has allowed only one run over his last 18.1 dating to the fifth inning on July 23rd.
- Allowed four home runs over two starts from July 18th-23rd, including three against Lowell on 7/18...Had not allowed a home run since August 17, 2009 with the DSL Mets against the DSL Giants prior to that start.
- Tossed 6.0 innings on June 26th vs. Aberdeen to collect his first win of the season... The 6.0 innings is tied for the the longest outing by a Cyclones pitcher this season.
- Has not walked more than two batters in any outing since July 7, 2008 with the DSL Mets against the DSL Blue Jays when he allowed three walks.
- Went 3-1 over his last four starts with the GCL Mets in 2010...Pitched at least 6.0 innings and allowed more than two runs only once.
- In 2009, went 7-1 as a starter with the DSL Mets...Did not allow more than three earned run in any of his 12 starts and allowed one earned or less in nine of 12... Pitched to a 1.74 (13 ERA / 67.1 IP) ERA.
